## Administrative Arrangements Act 1983

### ADMINISTRATIVE ARRANGEMENTS ORDER (NO. 202) 2009

1. **Title**  
This Order is called the Administrative Arrangements Order (No. 202) 2009.
2. **Authorising provision**  
This Order is made under section 3 of the **Administrative Arrangements Act 1983**.
3. **Commencement**  
This Order takes effect on 12 August 2009.
4. **Definitions**  
In this Order –  
‘**Body**’ means Minister, Department or officer;  
‘**instrument**’ includes contract and agreement;  
‘**Old Body**’ means a Body specified in Column 1 of the Schedule;  
‘**New Body**’ means a Body specified in Column 3 of the Schedule;  
‘**Schedule**’ means Schedule to this Order;  
‘**transaction**’ includes –
  - (a) agreement, bond, contract, deed or other consensual arrangement; and
  - (b) action, appeal, arbitration, prosecution or other legal proceeding; and
  - (c) assignment, charge, lease, mortgage, transfer or other dealing with property; and

**SPECIAL**

- (d) loan, guarantee, indemnity or other dealing with money; and
- (e) approval, consent, delegation, direction, licence, order, permit, requirement or other authority; and
- (f) notice; and
- (g) any other act, entitlement or liability at law.

**5. Construction of references**

In respect of each item in the Schedule, a reference to an Old Body –

- (a) in a provision of an Act specified in Column 2 of the Schedule; or
  - (b) in a statutory instrument or other instrument made under an Act specified in Column 2 of the Schedule; or
  - (c) in respect of any other matter or thing done under a provision of an Act specified in Column 2 of the Schedule; or
  - (d) in an instrument specified in Column 2 of the Schedule –
- is deemed to be a reference to the New Body.

**6 Saving of existing transactions**

If a transaction happened in relation to an Old Body before this Order takes effect –

- (a) the transaction shall continue in the same way it would have continued if this Order had not been made; and
- (b) the transaction may be given effect to, or enforced or completed, by or in relation to the New Body in the same way as it would have been given effect to, enforced or completed, by or in relation to the Old Body if this Order had not been made.

**7 Keeping financial accounts and reports**

The Secretary, Department of Human Services must ensure that financial accounts are kept and reports are provided for the purposes of the **Financial Management Act 1994** until 30 September 2009 in respect of functions under the Acts specified in item 1 in the Schedule that are transferred to the Secretary, Department of Health as if the functions had not been transferred.

**8 Providing financial accounts and reports**

The Secretary, Department of Health must, if requested by the Secretary, Department of Human Services, provide the Secretary, Department of Human Services with any financial accounts and records or other information required to enable the Secretary, Department of Human Services, to comply with clause 7.
