

Pursuant to section 206 and Schedule 10, Clause 3 of the **Local Government Act 1989**, the Moreland City Council has formed the opinion that the section of the road reserve at the side and front of 26 Walsh Street, Coburg, and shown by hatching on the plan below, is not reasonably required for public use and resolved to discontinue the road reserve and to sell the land by private treaty to the abutting owner at 26 Walsh Street, Coburg.

GLENELG PLANNING SCHEME Notice of Preparation of Amendment Amendment C74

The Glenelg Shire Council has prepared Amendment C74 to the Glenelg Planning Scheme.

In accordance with section 8A(3) of the **Planning and Environment Act 1987**, the Minister for Planning authorised the Glenelg Shire Council as planning authority to prepare the Amendment.

The Amendment affects land subject to flooding within the city of Portland and the townships of Narrawong and Casterton.

The Amendment proposes to:

- apply flooding controls (in the form of the Urban Floodway Zone, Floodway Overlay, and Land Subject to Inundation Overlay) to the affected areas of Portland, Narrawong and Casterton;
- rezone private land in Portland from the Urban Floodway Zone to the Residential 1 Zone and public land in the Urban Floodway Zone to the Public Use Zone – 3, Public Use

Zone – 4 and the Public Park and Recreation Zone to align with the most up-to-date flood extent mapping;

- introduce an Incorporated Document (Glenelg Shire Local Floodplain Development Plan August 2013) and amend Clause 61.03, accordingly; and
- amend the Schedule to Clause 44.03 – Floodway Overlay and the Schedule to Clause 44.04 – Land Subject to Inundation Overlay.
