(2) Subject to subsection (3), the remaining provisions of this Act come into operation on a day or days to be proclaimed.
(3) If a provision referred to in subsection (2) does not come into operation before 1 July 2015, it comes into operation on that day.
- 75/2014 (1) Subject to subsection (2), this Act comes into operation on a day or days to be proclaimed.
(2) If a provision of this Act does not come into operation before 1 September 2015, it comes into operation on that day.
- 76/2014 (1) Subject to subsection (2), this Act comes into operation on a day to be proclaimed.
(2) If a provision of this Act does not come into operation before 1 July 2015, it comes into operation on that day.
- 77/2014 (1) Subject to subsection (2), this Act comes into operation on a day or days to be proclaimed.
(2) If a provision of this Act does not come into operation before 18 September 2015, it comes into operation on that day.
