## Road Safety Act 1986

### DECLARATION UNDER SECTION 99B(4) IN RELATION TO NON-ROAD ACTIVITIES IN WOOLAMI FOR THE TOYOTA TV COMMERCIAL FILM SHOOT ON 18 FEBRUARY 2016

#### 1 Purpose

The purpose of this Declaration is to exempt participants in the Toyota TV Commercial Film Shoot from specified provisions of the **Road Safety Act 1986** and regulations under that Act.

#### 2 Authorising provision

This notice is made under section 99B(4) of the **Road Safety Act 1986**. Section 99B(4) provides that the Minister may, on the application of a person proposing to conduct a non-road activity on a highway, by notice published in the Government Gazette, declare that specified provisions of the **Road Safety Act 1986** and of the regulations made under that Act do not apply with respect to the non-road activity specified in the notice during the period specified in the notice. The 'Event' defined in Clause 5 of this notice is a non-road activity for the purpose of section 99B(4).

#### 3 Commencement

This notice takes effect at 10.00 am on 18 February 2016.

#### 4 Expiry

This notice expires at 4.00 pm on 18 February 2016.

#### 5 Definitions

In this notice, unless the context or subject matter otherwise requires –

- a) 'Event' means the Toyota TV Commercial Film Shoot, to be held on 18 February 2016;
- b) 'Participants' means participants in the Event, including officers, members and authorised agents of Revolver Films Pty Ltd, whose presence is reasonably required to ensure the safe conduct of the Event; and
- c) 'Applicant' means Revolver Films Pty Ltd.

#### 6 Declaration

I, John Cunningham, as delegate of the Minister for Roads and Road Safety, under section 99B(4) of the **Road Safety Act 1986** declare that the provisions of the **Road Safety Act 1986** and regulations specified in Table 1 do not apply to Participants engaged in activities forming part of the Event on the highway specified in column 1 of Table 2 on the date and during the period specified in column 2 of Table 2, provided that there is full compliance with the following conditions and any conditions imposed by the municipal council:

- The applicant and/or the safety officer must ensure that the crane cart on the tracking vehicle is suitably mounted onto the vehicle and that the tracking vehicle is suitable for its intended purpose and use.
- The applicant and/or safety officer must ensure that the stability of the tracking vehicle whilst filming is fit for its application during transit and filming.
- The crane on the tracking vehicle must be stowed away with no dangerous objects protruding from the vehicle during transit to and back from filming locations.
- The Event must be conducted in full compliance with the conditions in the relevant Permit granted by the Shire of Bass Coast and any conditions imposed by Victoria Police.

**SPECIAL**

- The Applicant must ensure that appropriate provision is made to allow residents to safely enter and leave their homes during the conduct of the Event.
- At least one marshal or official who is on location at the Event must carry a copy of the Permit granted by the Shire of Bass Coast, together with this Gazette notice, and must be able to produce them on request to any member of Victoria Police, or to any person who is an authorised officer under section 71 of the **Road Management Act 2004**.
- Participants in the event must obey a direction of a police officer or authorised officer at all times.
