I, Travis Dowling, Executive Director Fisheries Victoria, as delegate of the Minister for Agriculture and having considered the outcome of consultation in accordance with section 3A of the **Fisheries Act 1995** (the Act), make the following Fisheries Notice under section 152 of the Act:

### FISHERIES (HAZELWOOD PONDAGE) NOTICE NO. 7/2016

- 1. Title**  
This Notice may be cited as the Fisheries (Hazelwood Pondage) Notice No. 7/2016.
- 2. Objectives**  
The objectives of this Notice is to close Hazelwood Pondage to fishing.
- 3. Authorising provision**  
This Notice is made under sections 67, 114 and 152 of the Act.
- 4. Commencement**  
This Notice comes into operation on 20 April 2016.
- 5. Definitions**  
In this fisheries notice –  
**the Act** means the **Fisheries Act 1995**;  
**Hazelwood Pondage** means the waterbody adjoining Hazelwood Power Station in the Latrobe City municipality.
- 6. Prohibition on taking fish from Hazelwood Pondage**
  - (1) For the purposes of section 67 of the Act, the taking of any fish from, or the possession of any fish in, on or next to Hazelwood Pondage is prohibited.  
**Note:** A failure to comply with this prohibition is an offence under section 67(3) of the Act. A maximum penalty of 100 penalty units or 6 months imprisonment or both applies.
  - (2) Sub-clause (1) does not apply to a person acting in accordance with a permit under section 49 of the Act that specifically authorised the taking of fish in Hazelwood Pondage.
- 7. Prohibition on use or possession of recreational fishing equipment in Hazelwood Pondage**
  - (1) For the purposes of section 114 of the Act, the use or possession of recreational fishing equipment in, on or next to Hazelwood Pondage is prohibited.  
**Note:** A failure to comply with this prohibition is an offence under section 114(3) of the Act. A maximum penalty of 100 penalty units or 6 months imprisonment or both applies.
  - (2) Sub-clause (1) does not apply to a person acting in accordance with a permit under section 49 of the Act that specifically authorises the use or possession of recreational fishing equipment in, on or next to Hazelwood Pondage.
- 8. Revocation**  
Unless sooner revoked, this Notice will be automatically revoked on 20 October 2016.

**Note:** Section 152(3) of the Act provides that if a Fisheries Notice is inconsistent with any regulations, management plan, Ministerial direction, licence or permit, the Fisheries Notice prevails to the extent of the inconsistency.
