NOTICE OF PREPARATION OF REGULATORY IMPACT STATEMENT

Private Security Regulations 2016

Notice is given that, in accordance with section 11 of the **Subordinate Legislation Act 1994**, a Regulatory Impact Statement (RIS) has been prepared in relation to the proposed Private Security Regulations 2016 (the proposed Regulations).

This RIS proposes the remaking of the Private Security Regulations 2005 (the current Regulations), which make provision for matters required for the practical operation of the **Private Security Act 2004** (the Act). The proposed Regulations prescribe matters including classes of person to whom the Act does not apply, requirements for the keeping of records and registers under the Act, fees relating to licences, registrations and permits under the Act, and infringement penalties for certain offences under the Act.

The RIS examines the costs and benefits of the proposed Regulations and assesses alternatives.

The RIS concludes that the proposed Regulations are the best means of ensuring that the Act continues to function effectively to maintain and improve the integrity and competency of the private security industry.
