Notice of Approval of Amendment

Amendment VC132

The Minister for Planning has approved Amendment VC132 to the Victoria Planning Provisions (VPP) and all planning schemes in Victoria.

The Amendment comes into operation on the date this notice is published in the Government Gazette.

The Amendment changes the Victoria Planning Provisions and all planning schemes in Victoria by:

- making a number of administrative corrections and other changes to bushfire related provisions in Clause 13 (Environmental Risks), Clause 44.06 (Bushfire Management Overlay), Clause 52.47 (Planning for Bushfire), Clause 52.48 (Bushfire Protection: Exemptions), Clause 66 (Referral and Notice Provisions) and Clause 72 (General Terms)
- providing appropriate exemption from the need for public entities to apply for a planning permit in particular circumstances in Clause 36.03 (Public Conservation and Resource Zone)
- making a number of other administrative corrections and assorted changes throughout the VPP. The Amendment is available for public inspection on the Department of Environment, Land, Water and Planning (DELWP) website, www.delwp.vic.gov.au/public-inspection
