



Drugs, Poisons and Controlled Substances Act 1981

APPROVAL UNDER SECTION 14A

1. Under section 14A(1) of the **Drugs, Poisons and Controlled Substances Act 1981** ('the Act'), I, Jill Hennessy, Minister for Health, approve the Schedule 2, 3, 4 and 8 poisons listed in the health management protocols within the 9th edition of the Primary Clinical Care Manual for the purposes of the following authorisation under section 13(1)(bb):
 - a) in relation to any registered nurse whose registration is endorsed under section 94 of the Health Practitioner Regulation National Law as qualified to obtain, sell, supply and use Schedule 2, 3, 4 and 8 medicines, in the lawful practice of his or her profession as a registered nurse, for nursing practice in a rural and isolated practice area, and provided that the relevant poisons are obtained, sold, used and supplied in accordance with the health management protocols within the 9th edition of the Primary Clinical Care Manual for this approval;
2. Under section 14A (1A) of the Act, for the purposes of the above authorisation under section 13(1)(bb), I approve:
 - (a) the health services listed in clause 3 of this approval as the health services in which the Schedule 2, 3, 4 and 8 poisons listed in the 9th edition of the Primary Clinical Care Manual can be used, sold or supplied; and
 - (b) that the clinical circumstances in which the Schedule 2, 3, 4 and 8 poisons are to be used, sold or supplied are as set out in the health management protocols within the 9th edition of the Primary Clinical Care Manual.

Note: in this approval, the Primary Clinical Care Manual is the 9th edition 2016 written by Queensland Health and the Royal Flying Doctor Service (Queensland Section) at <http://www.health.qld.gov.au/pccm/> and as amended from time to time and published by the Queensland Government.

Note: a later edition of the Primary Clinical Care Manual is not to be taken as an amendment of the Primary Clinical Care Manual 9th edition.

This approval takes effect from the date of publication in the Victoria Government Gazette.

Education and Training Reform Act 2006

Pursuant to section 2.6.29 of the **Education and Training Reform Act 2006** ('the Act') a person who is registered as a teacher under Part 2.6 of the Act ceases to be so registered and is disqualified from teaching in a school if the person is convicted or found guilty in Victoria or elsewhere of a sexual offence as defined by the Act.

On 18 December 2017, Trenton Charles Hawkins, 38 year old male, being a person who was convicted of sexual offences in Victoria, being ten counts of sexual penetration of a 16 or 17 year old child under his care, supervision or authority, contrary to section 48(1) of the **Crimes Act 1958**, as in force in 2002, ceased to be a registered teacher in accordance with section 2.6.29(1) of the Act and was disqualified from teaching in a school or an early childhood service in accordance with section 2.6.29(3) of the Act.
