



DECLARATION OF BOATING ACTIVITY EXEMPTION

Strathbogrie Shire Council as the declared waterway manager for the Goulburn River from Hughes Creek to Goulburn Weir including Lake Nagambie, makes the following declaration under section 203(3) of the **Marine Safety Act 2010**.

For the purposes of boating activity conducted by Rowing Victoria, persons and vessels involved in the Head of the Goulburn are exempt from the following requirements:

**State Rules made under the Marine Act 1988**

1. Clause 2(a) – must not exceed 5 knots within 50 metres of a person in the water;
2. Clause 2(c) – must not exceed 5 knots within 50 meters of another vessel;
3. Clause 3(b) – must not exceed 5 knots within 50 metres of a fixed or floating structure;

**Waterway Rules made under the Marine Safety Act 2010/Marine Act 1988**

4. Clause 91.4(a) of Schedule 91 – 5 knot speed restriction on waters of the Goulburn River;
5. Clause 91.8 of Schedule 91 – Special Purpose Zones within the waters of the Goulburn River.

Subject to the conditions detailed below:

- Masters of competing vessels are only exempt from 1–5 in the above list when competing in the event.
- Masters of rescue vessels are only exempt from 1–4 in the above list when undertaking a rescue operation to retrieve persons in distress, provide for their initial medical or other needs and deliver them to a place of safety on shore, and at all other times must not exceed the speed of a competing rowing vessel.
- Masters of event official/umpire vessels are exempt from 2–5 in the above list for the duration of the event only and must not exceed the speed of a competing rowing vessel at any time unless in an emergency.
- Occupants of mechanically powered vessels involved with the event must wear a personal floatation device at all times during the event and all vessels must have all the prescribed safety equipment, including rescue vessels.
- The exemptions apply to persons and vessels participating in the ‘Head of the Goulburn’ Rowing Victoria event between 8.00 am and 2.00 pm on 26 October 2019, provided that the stated safety controls and undertakings detailed in the Application for Boating Activity exemptions and Exclusion Zones and Rowing Victoria Safety Management Plan, are adhered to.
