Radiation Act 2005

EXEMPTION FROM TRANSPORT SECURITY PLAN REQUIREMENTS

- 1. Exemption under section 16A(1) of the **Radiation Act 2005** from the requirement to prepare and provide an approved transport security plan and security compliance certificate:
 - (1) Martine Inspection Service Pty Ltd, a management licence holder within the meaning of the **Radiation Act 2005**, is exempt from preparing and providing to the Secretary of the Department of Health and Human Services an approved transport security plan and security compliance certificate in respect of the transport of industrial radiography equipment incorporating iridium-192, being a high consequence sealed source.
 - (2) Subclause (1) is subject to the following conditions:
 - (a) The exemption applies only in respect of the transport of industrial radiography equipment incorporating iridium-192, on the vessel Seven Eagle IMO Number 9015905 on Victorian coastal waters.
 - (b) The exemption is effective from 18 April 2019 until 30 April 2020.
