


- (a) the limits of the colony extend to the outline marked SEAL COLONY BOUNDARY; and


The Skerries, Croajingolong National Park




DETERMINATION OF THE TICONDEROGA BAY WHALE SANCTUARY ZONE

I, John Bradley, Secretary to the Department of Environment, Land, Water and Planning, under regulation 16(1) of the Wildlife (Marine Mammals) Regulations 2019, determine that the area of Ticonderoga Bay, hatched on the plan below, is a whale sanctuary zone. For the purposes of Regulation 16(2), the sanctuary zone applies to all whales, and the limits of the zone extend to the outline of the hatched area.
