NOTICE OF DECISION

Accident Towing Services Regulations 2019

I, Jaala Pulford, Minister for Roads and Minister responsible for administering the **Accident Towing Services Act 2007**, give notice in accordance with section 12 of the **Subordinate Legislation Act 1994** of my decision to make the proposed Accident Towing Services Regulations 2019 (the proposed Regulations).

A regulatory impact statement in relation to the proposed Regulations was made available for public comment and submissions from 10 October until 7 November 2019. The Department received one submission.

After consideration of the submissions in accordance with section 11 of the **Subordinate Legislation Act 1994** I have decided to make the proposed Regulations with the following amendments:

- removing certain payment methods prescribed in the proposed Regulations that may be offered to consumers of accident towing services; and
- the obligation for tow truck drivers to remove debris and glass before leaving an accident scene has been limited such that debris and glass must be removed 'as far as practicable'.
