NOTICE CONTROLLING NAVIGATION IN THE VICINITY OF WORKS

Parks Victoria, as the declared waterway manager for the waters of the Maribyrnong River upstream of Shepherd Bridge on Footscray Road makes the following notice under section 211(1)(b)(i) of the **Marine Safety Act 2010** (Vic.) (the Act).

For the purposes of the works activity proposed by Bellingham Marine Australia to undertake installation of a floating landing at Footscray Park. The navigation and movement of vessels is prohibited in the waters of the Maribyrnong River as detailed below, excluding vessels involved in the works, and Parks Victoria vessels.

The prohibited area is 60 metres in length and extends 20 metres from the south bank and is located upstream of Lynchs Bridge at Ballarat Road.

The prohibited works area will be marked by 4 lit yellow communication buoys with sign float information buoys.

This notice has effect from 7.00 am on Monday 15 June 2020 through to 5.00 pm on Wednesday 24 June 2020.

Times and dates are subject to change. Changes to times, durations or days will be advertised on Parks Victoria's website and Notice to River Users.
