

DETERMINATION OF THE MALOP STREET GREEN SPINE PROJECT TO BE A DESIGNATED ROAD PROJECT

I, Ben Carroll, Minister for Roads and Road Safety, under section 16 of the **Road Management Act 2004**, determine as follows:

1. The road project known as the Malop Street Green Spine project is a Designated Road Project.
2. The Road Authority to which the Designated Road Project is assigned is the Head, Transport for Victoria.
3. The project area for the purposes of the Designated Road Project is designated as the area within the City of Greater Geelong, comprising the parts of the road reserve shown and described in the legends on the attached map 'Malop Street Green Spine Project Declaration GP DP_39, GP DP_39A, GP DP_39B.
4. The period during which this determination is to operate is from the day this is published in the Government Gazette, for a period of 5 years from that date or, if this determination is earlier revoked, until the day on which it is revoked.

Road Management Act 2004**DIRECTION TO HEAD, TRANSPORT FOR VICTORIA WITH RESPECT TO
MALOP STREET GREEN SPINE PROJECT**

I, Ben Carroll, Minister for Roads and Road Safety:

- having determined that the Malop Street Green Spine Project (Project) is a Designated Road Project under section 16 of the **Road Management Act 2004** (the Act); and
- having specified that the Head, Transport for Victoria as the road authority to which the designated road project is assigned; and
- having designated a project area for the purpose of the Designated Road Project; and
- noting that the Head, Transport for Victoria may, pursuant to section 119(1)(b) of the Act, perform any road management function under the Act on any road in relation to the project assigned to the Head, Transport for Victoria by the Minister; and
- considering that it is in the public interest to do so –

direct the Head, Transport for Victoria under section 22 of the Act, to perform the functions and exercise the powers of coordinating road authority and a responsible road authority with respect to the Designated Road Project in the following manner:

- in consultation with the Revitalising Central Geelong Partnership; and
- having regard to any processes and policies that the City of Greater Geelong would have regard to if it was the coordinating road authority and responsible road authority with respect to the project area.

I further direct the Head, Transport for Victoria;

- as soon as is practicable after the completion of the Project, commission or have carried out a survey of any road in the Project area of which the boundaries have or may not have been altered in the course of the Project; and
- as soon as possible after the Project ceases to be a Designated Road Project, to
 - declare the roads within the Project area as municipal roads or other appropriate road classifications as applicable as agreed between the Head, Transport for Victoria and the City of Greater Geelong, or
 - vary or revoke the existing declarations of the roads within the Project area as arterial roads, municipal roads or other appropriate road classifications, or
 - discontinue any parts of existing roads of all roads in the Project area to the extent necessary to ensure that all boundaries of the roads as declared align with the boundaries of the roads as they were immediately before the commencement of the Project or if altered in the course of the Project as determined by survey.
