Control of Weapons Act 1990

PROTECTIVE SERVICES OFFICERS – WEAPON EXEMPTION

Order in Council

The Governor in Council under section 8B of the **Control of Weapons Act 1990** exempts the class of persons listed in Column 1 of the Table below from sections 5(1), 5(1A) and 5AA of the **Control of Weapons Act 1990** as these sections apply to activities listed in Column 2 of the Table in relation to the item listed in Column 3 of the Table, for the purposes listed in Column 4 of the Table.

Column 1 Class of person	Column 2 Activity	Column 3 Item	Column 4 Purpose
Protective Services Officer	Bring into Victoria, cause to be brought into or sent into Victoria, possess, use or carry oleoresin capsicum spray.	An article designed or adapted to discharge oleoresin capsicum spray	That officer's official duties.
