Gambling Regulation Act 2003

Section 4.5.10

Notice is hereby given that the Victorian Commission for Gambling and Liquor Regulation makes the following variations to approved betting events, in accordance with section 4.5.11(1)(a) of the **Gambling Regulation Act 2003** (the Act), with effect from the date of publication of this notice.

In relation to approvals under sections 4.5.6(1)(a) and 4.5.6(1)(b) and determinations under section 4.5.9(a) of the Act, the Commission varies (wherever appearing):

American Football: Matches controlled and regulated by national or international authorities, to:

American Football events administered by a national or international authority.

Athletics: Meetings controlled and regulated by national or international authorities, to:

Athletics events administered by a national or international authority.

Australian Football: Games that form part of the Australian Football League and Victorian Football League competitions including the State of Origin series and the Brownlow Medal Vote Count, to:

Australian football events administered by the Australian Football League or the Victorian Football League.

Badminton: Controlled and regulated by Badminton Australia and/or Badminton World Federation except for those competitions restricted to age groups less than 18 years of age, and when those events are contested in the following tournaments:

- Badminton World Championships
- Badminton Super Series
- The Uber Cup
- The Sudirman Cup
- The Badminton Grand Prix
- Li Ning, Clendinnen Shield
- Australian Closed Championships, to:

Badminton events administered by a national or international authority.

Baseball: Matches controlled and regulated by national or international authorities, to:

Baseball events administered by a national or international authority.

Basketball: Matches controlled and regulated by national or international authorities, to:

Basketball events administered by a national or international authority.

Boxing: Contests controlled and regulated by national or international authorities (subject to the condition that separate individual approval of boxing contests taking place in the Commonwealth of Australia be sought except if the contest is an officially sanctioned national and international boxing title fight), to:

Boxing events administered by a national or international authority (subject to the condition that separate individual approval of boxing contests taking place in the Commonwealth of Australia be sought except if the contest is an officially sanctioned national or international boxing title fight).

Cricket: Matches controlled and regulated by national or international authorities, to:

Cricket events administered by a national or international authority.

SPECIAL

Cycling: Events controlled and regulated by national or international authorities, to:

Cycling events administered by a national or international authority.

Darts: Events controlled and regulated by the World Darts Federation of the Professional Darts Corporation, to:

Darts events administered by the World Darts Federation (WDF), the Professional Darts Corporation (PDC) or a national member organisation of the WDF or PDC.

Field Hockey: Field Hockey events controlled and regulated by national or international authorities, to:

Field Hockey events administered by national or international authority.

Golf: Events controlled and regulated by national or international authorities, to:

Golf events administered by a national or international authority.

Ice Hockey: Matches controlled and regulated by the American National Ice Hockey League, to:

Ice Hockey events administered by the American National Ice Hockey League.

International Rules: Games controlled and regulated by the Australian Football League and the Gaelic Athletic Association, to:

International Rules events administered by the Australian Football League and the Gaelic Athletic Association.

Ironman: Events controlled and regulated by national or international authorities, to:

Ironman events administered by a national or international authority.

Lawn Bowls: Controlled and regulated by Bowls Australia and/or World Bowls when those events are contested in the following competitions (except those competitions restricted to age groups less than 18 years of age):

- Bowls Australia Australian Premier League
- Bowls Australia Australian Open
- Bowls Australia Indoor Championships
- Bowls Australia Australian Sides Championships
- Bowls Australia National Champion of Champions
- events and tournaments conducted and controlled by Bowls Australia
- events and tournaments conducted and controlled by World Bowls, to:

Lawn Bowls events administered by a national or international authority.

Motor Sport: Races controlled and regulated by national or international authorities, to:

Motor Sport events administered by a national or international authority.

Netball: Matches controlled and regulated by national and international authorities, to:

Netball events administered by a national or international authority.

Olympic and Commonwealth Games: Contingencies of, or relating to events at Olympic and Commonwealth Games, to:

Olympic and Commonwealth Games events at Olympic and Commonwealth games.

Professional Snooker: Events controlled and regulated by the World Professional Billiards and Snooker Association, to:

Professional Snooker events administered by the World Professional Billiards and Snooker Association.

Rugby League: Matches controlled and regulated by national or international authorities, to:

Rugby League events administered by a national or international authority.

Rugby Union: Matches controlled and regulated by national or international authorities, to:

Rugby Union events administered by a national or international authority.

Soccer: Matches controlled and regulated by national or international authorities, to:
Soccer events administered by a national or international authority.

Surfing: Events controlled and regulated by national or international authorities, to:
Surfing events administered by a national or international authority.

Tennis: Tournaments controlled and regulated by state, national and international authorities, to:
Tennis events administered by a national or international authority.

Triathlon: Events controlled and regulated by national and international authorities, to:
Triathlon events administered by a national or international authority.

Volleyball (including Beach Volleyball): Controlled and regulated by Volleyball Australia and/or the International Volleyball Federation (FIVB – Federation Internationale de Volleyball) in the following non-restrictive aged tournaments:

- FIVB World Championships
- events sanctioned by FIVB or affiliated internal or national organisations, such as Men’s and Women’s World League, World Grand Prix, World Championships, World Cup
- beach volleyball events sanctioned by FIVB or affiliated international or national organisations, such as Men’s and Women’s Renault National Beach Volleyball series
- Olympic Games, to:
Volleyball (including Beach Volleyball) events administered by a national or international authority.

Yachting: Events controlled and regulated by national or international authorities, to:
Yachting events administered by a national or international authority.

Notice is hereby given by the Victorian Commission for Gambling and Liquor Regulation that – With effect from the date of publication of this notice, the Victorian Commission for Gambling and Liquor Regulation varies, in accordance with section 4.5.17(1)(a) of the **Gambling Regulation Act 2003**, the following Sports Controlling Body approvals:

The Australian Football League, approved under section 4.5.15 of the **Gambling Regulation Act 2003**, as a Sports Controlling Body for sports betting purposes, for:

Any Australian football event controlled, organised or administered by the Australian Football League.

Varied from:

The Australian Football League (AFL) is the sports controlling body for:

- all AFL games that fall within the AFL pre-season competition
- AFL Premiership season competition
- AFL Finals series
- Brownlow Medal vote count
- AFLW season competition
- AFLW Finals series
- AFLW Awards
- all AFLX games that fall within the AFLX competition.

Basketball Australia, approved under section 4.5.15 of the **Gambling Regulation Act 2003** as a Sports Controlling Body for sports betting purposes, for:

Any basketball event controlled, organised or administered by Basketball Australia.

Varied from:

Basketball Australia is the sports controlling body for the following sports betting events:

- any basketball match or competition controlled, organised or administered by Basketball Australia including, but not limited to, National Basketball League and Women's Basketball League games
- games involving Australian National teams
- international games or competitions conducted by Basketball Australia.

Bowls Australia, approved under section 4.5.15 of the **Gambling Regulation Act 2003** as a Sports Controlling Body for sports betting purposes, for:

Any bowls event controlled, organised or administered by Bowls Australia.

Varied from:

Bowls Australia is the sports controlling body for the following bowls sports betting events:

- Australian Premier League
- Australian Open
- Australian Indoor Championships
- Australian Sides Championships
- National Champion of Champions
- events and tournaments conducted and controlled by Bowls Australia.

Confederation of Australian Motor Sports (CAMS), approved under section 4.5.15 of the **Gambling Regulation Act 2003** as a Sports Controlling Body for sports betting purposes, for:

Any motor sport event controlled, organised or administered by CAMS.

Varied from:

Confederation of Australian Motor Sports (CAMS) is the sports controlling body for all motor sport race events, championships and competitions it controls and regulates.

Cricket Australia, approved under section 4.5.15 of the **Gambling Regulation Act 2003** as a Sports Controlling Body for sports betting purposes, for:

Any cricket event controlled, organised or administered by Cricket Australia.

Varied from:

Cricket Australia is the sports controlling body for any cricket match or competition conducted under the jurisdiction or sponsorship of Cricket Australia.

Football Federation Australia Limited (FFA), approved under section 4.5.15 of the **Gambling Regulation Act 2003** as a Sports Controlling Body for sports betting purposes, for:

Any soccer event controlled, organised or administered by the Football Federation Australia Limited.

Varied from:

Football Federation Australia Limited (FFA) is the sports controlling body for the following sports betting events:

- all football matches played in Australia between a national team representing Australia and a national team representing another nation (including junior and women's teams)
- all football matches played in Australia between football clubs that are members of the A-League, including the A-League pre-season, A-League regular season, A-League finals series, the National Youth League and W-League
- all football matches played in Australia between a professional club that is a member of a national association other than FFA and either:
 - a club who is a member of FFA
 - or another professional club that is a member of a national association other than the Football Federation Australia
- all football matches played in Australia between two national associations who are members of Federation International de Football Association
- the football competitions conducted in each of the Australian states and territories by member federations of the FFA.

National Rugby League, approved under section 4.5.15 of the **Gambling Regulation Act 2003** as a Sports Controlling Body for sports betting purposes, for:

Any rugby league event controlled, organised or administered by the National Rugby League.

Varied from:

National Rugby League is the sports controlling body for the control and regulation of all matches either solely or in conjunction with the Australian Rugby League.

Netball Australia, approved under section 4.5.15 of the **Gambling Regulation Act 2003** as a Sports Controlling Body for sports betting purposes, for:

Any netball event controlled, organised or administered by Netball Australia.

Varied from:

Netball Australia is the sports controlling body for the following sports betting events:

- all events controlled and regulated by Netball Australia
- matches featuring the Australian Netball Diamonds
- matches featuring the Australian FastNet Diamonds
- ANZ Championship matches featuring the Australian teams.

Professional Golfers Association of Australia (PGA of Australia), approved under section 4.5.15 of the **Gambling Regulation Act 2003** as a Sports Controlling Body for sports betting purposes, for:

Any golf event controlled, organised or administered by the PGA of Australia.

Varied from:

Professional Golfers Association of Australia is the sports controlling body for the control and regulation of all golf events.

Tennis Australia, approved under section 4.5.15 of the **Gambling Regulation Act 2003** as a Sports Controlling Body for sports betting purposes, for:

Any tennis event controlled, organised or administered by Tennis Australia.

Varied from:

Tennis Australia is the sports controlling body for the control and regulation of all tennis tournaments.

Rugby Australia, approved under section 4.5.15 of the **Gambling Regulation Act 2003** as a Sports Controlling Body for sports betting purposes, for:

Any rugby union event controlled, organised or administered by Rugby Australia.

Varied from:

Australian Rugby Union is the sports controlling body for:

- Super Rugby
- matches featuring the Wallabies
- men's Australia Sevens matches
- women's Australia Sevens matches
- Australia A matches
- Australia under-20s matches
- National Rugby Championship.

Conditions of approval:

Agreements made with sports betting providers must be communicated to the Victorian Commission for Gambling and Liquor Regulation within 14 days of agreements being made.
