Country Fire Authority Act 1958

DECLARATION OF FIRE DANGER PERIOD

In pursuance of the powers conferred by section 4 of the **Country Fire Authority Act 1958**, I, Alen Slijepcevic, Acting Chief Officer of the Country Fire Authority, after consultation with the Secretary to the Department of Environment, Land, Water and Planning, hereby declare the following periods to be the Fire Danger Period in the municipal districts of the municipalities or parts of municipalities specified, commencing on the dates shown and, unless varied by subsequent declaration, ending at 0100 hours on 1 May 2021.

To commence from 0100 hours on 30 November 2020:

- Pyrenees Shire Council (Northern Part) That part north and east of the line described by the following: Shire Boundary at Old Geelong Road to St Marnocks Road then south to Mt William Road then north to Meadows Lane to Beaufort Carranballac Road to Stockyard Hill Wangaratta Road then south along Stockyard Hill Road to Carngham–Streatham Road east to Mortchup Mount Emu Road south to Chepstowe Pittong Road to Shire Boundary

- Towong Shire Council
- Wodonga City Council
