




Locality Map

Proposed Non-Emergency Patient Transport Amendment Regulations 2021

I, Martin Foley, Minister for Health, give notice under section 12 of the **Subordinate Legislation Act 1994** (the Act) that I have decided that the proposed Non-Emergency Patient Transport Amendment Regulations 2021 (proposed Regulations) are to be made.

A regulatory impact statement was published, and public comments and submissions were invited, as required by section 11(2) of the Act. The sixteen submissions received have been considered, as required by section 11(3) of the Act.

Subject to the matters below, I have decided that the proposed Regulations should be made substantially unchanged, with minor amendments to improve the clarity, operation and practicality of the proposed regulations.

The main changes are:

- the inclusion of a requirement that all low acuity stretcher patients must have a crew member travel in the compartment with them to ensure continual monitoring of the condition of the patient;
- removal of the requirement for face to face training as it is not possible in a COVID environment;
- a power for the Secretary to exempt vehicles from the requirement to be replaced at 400,000 km provided certain safety conditions are met. The exclusion will be limited to vehicles used solely for rural patient transport;
- the exclusion of non-stretcher vehicles from a number of provisions to provide clarity;
- inclusion of a registered nurse or paramedic in the clinical governance committee where a licence holder employs people with these qualifications, to ensure appropriate clinical oversight occurs;
- revision of some definitions for clarity and to align with common usage elsewhere in the health system.

The Regulations are otherwise substantially unchanged with only minor and technical updates.
