## Water Act 1989

### DIRECTION TO GIPPSLAND AND SOUTHERN RURAL WATER CORPORATION

#### Order in Council

The Governor in Council under section 159E of the **Water Act 1989** and on the recommendation of the Acting Minister for Water, directs Gippsland and Southern Rural Water Corporation to consider and decide the following applications made in order to construct or alter works and take water to mitigate risks to the Yallourn mine associated with the cracking on the east bank of the Morwell River Diversion, without applying sections 40(1), 51B, 53, 67A and 68 of the **Water Act 1989**:

- (a) an application for a licence made under section 67 of the **Water Act 1989**;
- (b) an application for a licence made under section 51 of the **Water Act 1989** to take such volume of water as is necessary to prevent risks to the Yallourn mine.

This Order takes effect on the date of its publication in the Government Gazette and remains in effect, unless revoked earlier, until 11:59 pm on 31 October 2021.
