NOTICE CONTROLLING NAVIGATION IN THE VICINITY OF WORKS

Parks Victoria, as the declared waterway manager for the waters of the Yarra River upstream of the port waters of the Port of Melbourne, makes the following notice under section 211(1)(b)(i) of the **Marine Safety Act 2010** (the Act).

For the purposes of the works activity proposed by Australasian Marine Associates to undertake maintenance dredging of the Lower Yarra River, an additional two sites as outlined in Table 1 supplementing the Notice first published in the Victorian Government Gazette S146 on Friday 25 March 2022.

The navigation and movement of vessels is prohibited on the waters of the Yarra River as detailed below in Table 1, excluding vessels involved in the works and Parks Victoria vessels.

Table 1: Lower Yarra River dredging – additional sites

Location/Dates	Prohibited Waters	Works activity	Open for transit
Banana Alley Friday 3 June to Tuesday 7 June 2022	Downstream of Queens Bridge to upstream of Sandridge Bridge. An exclusion zone of approximately 70 metres long and 6 metres wide from the northern bank will be established as marked by buoys and signage. The exclusion zone may move as required within the area.	Maintenance dredging to reinstate functional depth	Open. Approximately 75 metres wide transit lane from the southern bank.
VRA Landing Thursday 30 June to Saturday 16 July 2022	Entire VRA Landing area, half will remain open at all times. An exclusion zone of approximately 180 metres long and 15 metres wide from the southern bank will be established as marked by buoys and signage. The exclusion zone may move as required within the area.	Maintenance dredging to reinstate functional depth	Open. Approximately 60 metres wide transit lane from the northern bank.

The exclusion zones will be marked by stringline buoyage, lit water communication buoys fitted with 1–2 nm marine lanterns and lit warning signage on approach from both upstream and downstream.

Times and dates are subject to change. Changes to times, durations or days will be advertised on Parks Victoria’s website and Notice to River Users.

This notice has effect from 8.00 am on 25 March 2022 to 5.00 pm on 30 September 2022.
