#### Road Management Act 2004

#### DESIGNATION OF TOW AWAY AREA UNDER SCHEDULE 4 CLAUSE 5

Tow Away Area for the 2022 Firelight Festival

Clause 5 of Schedule 4 to the **Road Management Act 2004** provides that a State road authority may move, keep or impound any vehicle that is unlawfully parked or left standing in an area designated by the Minister, (referred to in this instrument as a 'tow-away area'), and may charge the owner of the vehicle a reasonable fee.

For the purposes of that provision, I, Angela Grice, Executive Director Network Change at the Department of Transport and delegate of the Minister for Roads, designate the locations specified and shown on the attached plan, to be a tow-away area to facilitate the 2022 Firelight Festival to be held in Melbourne.

This instrument takes effect from 5.00 pm Thursday 30 June 2022 until midnight (12.00 am) Sunday 3 July 2022.

Harbour Esplanade, between La Trobe Street and Bourke Street (both sides)
