ORDER DECLARING THAT CERTAIN DISEASES ARE ELIGIBLE PROGRESSIVE DISEASES

Order in Council

The Lieutenant-Governor, as the Governor's deputy, with the advice of the Executive Council, under section 51A of the **Workplace Injury Rehabilitation and Compensation Act 2013**, on the recommendation of the Minister for Workplace Safety, declares that diseases specified in the Schedule are considered to be eligible progressive diseases for the purposes of the **Workplace Injury Rehabilitation and Compensation Act 2013**.

This Order comes into effect on the date it is published in the Government Gazette.

- a. Asbestosis, with or without mesothelioma, attributable to exposure to asbestos
- b. Silicosis, with or without pulmonary tuberculosis, that is attributable to exposure to silica dust
- c. Scleroderma with silicosis, that is attributable to exposure to silica dust
- d. Lung cancer with silicosis, that is attributable to exposure to silica dust
- e. Primary site brain cancer
- f. Primary site bladder cancer
- g. Primary site kidney cancer
- h. Primary non-Hodgkins lymphoma
- i. Primary leukemia
- j. Primary site breast cancer
- k. Primary site testicular cancer
- l. Multiple myeloma
- m. Primary site prostate cancer
- n. Primary site ureter cancer
