Road Safety Act 1986

ORDER UNDER SECTION 96A

Variation of Rules under the Road Safety Road Rules 2017

Under section 96A of the **Road Safety Act 1986**, I, the Hon. Ben Carroll, Minister for Roads and Road Safety, declare that the operation of the following rules of the Road Safety Road Rules 2017 are varied as described below for the period commencing from the day this notice is published to 12 August 2022 (inclusive).

Rule 104(8) — Despite anything to the contrary in this rule, a driver of a vehicle described in rule 179(1)(c) to (f) which is engaged in the delivery of food items or personal hygiene products to premises where the public may purchase those items or products is permitted to pass a 'no trucks' sign to make that delivery at any time of the day;

Rule 179(2A) – Despite anything to the contrary in this rule, a driver of a vehicle described in rule 179(1)(c) to (f) which is stopped in a loading zone because the driver is dropping off or picking up food items or personal hygiene products to or from premises where the public may purchase those items or products may stay continuously in that loading zone for 15 minutes extra than the time permitted under subrule (2).
