Disability Service Safeguards Act 2018

Section 130

INTERIM PROHIBITION ORDER

This Interim Prohibition Order is made pursuant to section 130 of the **Disability Service Safeguards Act 2018**.

I, Daniel Stubbs, the Victorian Disability Worker Commissioner (Commissioner) make this Interim Prohibition Order (Interim Prohibition Order) because the below ground(s) exists and I am satisfied that it is necessary to make this Interim Prohibition Order to avoid a serious risk to the life, health, safety or welfare of a person or the health, safety or welfare of the public.

Ground(s) for making the Interim Prohibition Order:	This Interim Prohibition Order is made in accordance with section 133(e) of the Disability Service Safeguards Act 2018
Date this Interim Prohibition Order is made:	30 September 2022
Date this Interim Prohibition Order takes effect:	4 October 2022
Date on which this Interim Prohibition Order expires:	An Interim Prohibition Order can remain in force for up to 12 weeks. This Interim Prohibition Order will remain in force for 12 weeks from the date it comes into effect and will expire on 26 December 2022 unless it is revoked before that date.
Effect of this Interim Prohibition Order:	<p>The unregistered disability worker is: prohibited from providing any disability services in Victoria. Under section 3 of the Disability Service Safeguards Act 2018, a disability service means –</p> <p>(a) a service (other than a prescribed exempt service) which involves more than incidental contact with a person with a disability and is specifically provided to the person for the principal purpose of caring for, or treating, the person or supporting the person to manage the person’s limitations in undertaking one or more of the following activities –</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">(i) communication;(ii) social or economic participation;(iii) social interaction;(iv) learning;(v) mobility;(vi) self-care;(vii) self-management; or <p>(b) a prescribed service;</p>

SPECIAL

In this Interim Prohibition Order ‘unregistered disability worker’ and ‘disability service’ have the same meaning as in section 3 of the **Disability Service Safeguards Act 2018**.

This Interim Prohibition Order takes effect on the date specified in the Order.

Contravention of an Interim Prohibition Order is an offence under the **Disability Service Safeguards Act 2018**.
