DESIGNATION OF TOW AWAY AREAS UNDER CLAUSE 4 OF SCHEDULE 11

Australian Motorcycle Grand Prix 14 – 16 October 2022

World Superbike Championship 18 – 20 November 2022

Clause 4 of Schedule 11 to the **Local Government Act 1989** provides that a Council may move or impound any vehicle that is causing an unlawful obstruction, or that is unlawfully parked or left standing in an area designated by the Minister (referred to in this instrument as a tow away area) and may charge the owner of the vehicle a fee of up to the amount of the fee set for the purposes of Clause 3(1)(c).

- I, Beth Liley, Director Gippsland, under Clause 4 of Schedule 11 to the **Local Government Act 1989**, designate –
- (a) every area to which a no stopping sign applies; and
- (b) every area to which a no parking sign applies

on the roads in the Shire of Bass Coast listed below to be a tow away area from 12.01 am on Friday 14 October 2022 to 11.59 pm on Sunday 16 October 2022 and from 12.01 am on Friday 18 November 2022 to 11.59 pm on Sunday 20 November 2022.

In this instrument –

area to which a no stopping sign applies means a length of road or an area to which a no stopping sign applies in accordance with rule 167 of the Road Safety Road Rules 2017

area to which a no parking sign applies means a length of road or an area to which a no parking sign applies in accordance with rule 168 of the Road Safety Road Rules 2017



- Phillip Island Tourist Road from Back Beach Road, Phillip Island to Bass Highway merge;
- Smiths Beach Road between Back Beach Road and Phillip Island Tourist Road;
- Berry's Beach Road between Back Beach Road and Ventnor Road;
- Back Beach Road between Phillip Island Tourist Road and Berry's Beach Road;
- Pyramid Rock Road between Ventnor Road and Back Beach Road;
- Gap Road.

This instrument takes effect on the day it is published in the Government Gazette.
