Road Management Act 2004

DESIGNATION OF TOW AWAY AREA UNDER SCHEDULE 4 CLAUSE 5

Tow Away Area for the Antipodes Lonsdale Street Festival 2022

Clause 5 of Schedule 4 to the **Road Management Act 2004** provides that a State road authority may move, keep or impound any vehicle that is unlawfully parked or left standing in an area designated by the Minister, (referred to in this instrument as a 'tow-away area'), and may charge the owner of the vehicle a reasonable fee.

For the purposes of that provision, I, David Teague, Acting Executive Director, Inner Metro at the Department of Transport and delegate of the Minister for Roads, designate the locations specified and shown on the attached plan, to be a tow-away area to facilitate the Antipodes Lonsdale Street Festival 2022 to be held in Melbourne.

This instrument takes effect from 6.00 pm Friday 21 October 2022 until 5.00 am 24 October 2022.


- Lonsdale Street between Swanston Street and Jones Lane,
