CONSEQUENTIAL RULE

I, Cameron Toy, Director Maritime Safety (as delegate of Safe Transport Victoria) make the following consequential rule under section 185 of the **Marine Safety Act 2010** which is consequential to the making of the waterway rules below.

The rules regulating the operation of vessels on the waters of The Local Port of Port Phillip as detailed in clause 1.4.13 (b) of Schedule 1 The Local Port of Port Phillip made in the Notice under section 184 of the **Marine Safety Act 2010** and published in Victoria Government Gazette No. S 142 on 5 June 2015 and as amended in Victoria Government Gazette No. S 686 on 22 December 2020 are hereby revoked.

WATERWAY RULE

I, Cameron Toy, Director Maritime Safety (as delegate of Safe Transport Victoria) make the following waterway rule under section 184 of the **Marine Safety Act 2010**.

SCHEDULE 1: The Local Port of Port Phillip

Waterway Manager: Parks Victoria

1.4.13 Exclusive use and special purpose areas

The following waters are shared wind-sports areas.

(b) Waters bounded by a line commencing at a signpost displaying a wind-sports sign^{pw07} on the foreshore approximately 20 metres east of the foot of the Point Richards breakwater, extending seaward west to the end of the breakwater, then northward approximately 40 metres to a port lateral buoy^{pr02}, then extending north-west approximately 120 metres to a port lateral buoy^{pr03}, then extending in an arc approximately 571 metres north-east to a yellow special mark buoy^{pw02}, then extending approximately 240 metres south to a signpost displaying a wind-sports sign^{pw08}, on the foreshore approximately 100 metres west of the Portarlington Sailing Club.
