#### Control of Weapons Act 1990

## VICTORIA POLICE – PROHIBITED WEAPON EXEMPTION – CONDUCTED ENERGY DEVICE

Order in Council

The Governor in Council under section 8B of the Control of Weapons Act 1990 orders that –

#### Commencement

This Order comes into operation on the day it is published in the Government Gazette.

#### **Definitions**

In this Order -

- (a) **conducted energy device** means an article designed or adapted to emit an electric current into a human body for the purposes of incapacitation or injury;
- (b) protective services officer has the same meaning as in the Victoria Police Act 2013; and
- (c) Victoria Police employee has the same meaning as in the Victoria Police Act 2013.

#### Exemption

A person listed in Column 1 of the Table is exempt from sections 5(1), 5(1AA), 5(1AB), 5(1A) and 5AA of the **Control of Weapons Act 1990** as the section applies to an activity listed in Column 2 of the Table in relation to an item listed in Column 3 of the Table, for the purpose listed in Column 4 of the Table.

#### **Condition**

It is a condition of the exemption in this Order that a person who possesses a conducted energy device or a cartridge for a conducted energy device must store the conducted energy device or the cartridge for a conducted energy device (as the case requires) as if –

- (a) a conducted energy device were a general category handgun within the meaning of the Firearms Act 1996; and
- (b) a cartridge for a conducted energy device were cartridge ammunition within the meaning of the **Firearms Act 1996**.

#### Revocation

The Order of the Governor in Council made under section 8B of the **Control of Weapons Act 1990** dated 1 June 2021 and published on pages 1113 to 1114 of the Government Gazette No. G 22 on 3 June 2021 relating to a prohibited weapon that is a conducted energy device is **revoked**.

#### Variation

The Order of the Governor in Council made pursuant to section 8B(a)(ii) of the **Control of Weapons Act 1990** on 20 April 2004 and published on page 961 of the Victoria Government Gazette No. G 17 on 22 April 2004 is **varied** so that it does not apply in relation to a prohibited weapon that is a conducted energy device.
