NOTICE CONTROLLING NAVIGATION IN THE VICINITY OF WORKS

Parks Victoria, as the declared waterway manager for the waters of the Yarra River upstream of the port waters of the Port of Melbourne, makes the following notice under section 211(1)(b)(i) of the Marine Safety Act 2010 (the Act).

For the purposes of the works activity proposed by Australasian Marine Associates to undertake maintenance dredging of the Lower Yarra River, this notice supersedes and amends the previous notices published in the Victoria Government Gazette S 146 on Friday 25 March 2022, S 275 on Thursday 2 June 2022, and S 430 Monday 29 August 2022.

The navigation and movement of vessels is prohibited on the waters of the Yarra River as detailed below in Table 1, excluding vessels involved in the works and Parks Victoria vessels.

An exclusion zone of approximately 400 m long and 35 m wide from the southern bank will be established as marked by buoys and signage. The exclusion zone may move as required within the area.	Maintenance dredging to reinstate functional depth	Open. Approximately 45 m wide transit lane from the northern bank.

Disposal Site Monday 29 August to Sunday 23 November 2022	Upstream of Bolte Bridge on northern and southern banks. Exclusion zones of approximately 50 m long and 45 m wide from either the northern or southern banks will be established as marked by buoys and signage.	Discharge of dredge material	Open. Approximately 80 m wide central transit lane.
	The exclusion zone may move as required within the area.		
Main Yarra Trail Floating Section Friday 11 November to Friday 18 November 2022	Between Hoddle Bridge and Cremorne Rail Bridge. An exclusion zone of approximately 180 m long and 20 m wide along the floating section of the Main Yarra Trail from the northern bank will be established as marked by buoys and signage. The exclusion zone may move as required within the area.	Maintenance dredging to reinstate functional depth	Open. Approximately 20 m wide transit lane from the southern bank.
Caroline Street Landing Monday 30 January to Thursday 2 February 2023	Downstream of Cremorne Rail Bridge. An exclusion zone of approximately 60 m long and 25 m wide from the southern bank will be established as marked by buoys and signage.	Maintenance dredging to reinstate functional depth	Open. Approximately 30 m wide transit lane from the northern bank.
Punt Road Landing Thursday 2 February to Monday 6 February 2023	Upstream of Hoddle Bridge and Cremorne Rail Bridge. An exclusion zone of approximately 60 m long and 25 m wide from the southern bank will be established as marked by buoys and signage.	Maintenance dredging to reinstate functional depth	Open. Approximately 25 m wide transit lane from the northern bank.

The exclusion zones will be marked by stringline buoyage, lit water communication buoys fitted with 1–2 nm marine lanterns and lit warning signage on approach from both upstream and downstream.

Times and dates are subject to change. Changes to times, durations or days will be advertised on Parks Victoria's website and Notice to River Users.

This notice has effect from 7.00 am on 25 October 2022 to 5.00 pm on 6 February 2023. Dated 20 October 2022
