Road Safety Act 1986

ORDER UNDER SECTION 98 OF THE ROAD SAFETY ACT 1986 EXTENDING PROVISIONS TO OFF-STREET PARKING FACILITIES AND PARKING ACCESS ROADS AT CERTAIN RAILWAY STATIONS

I, Fiona Adamson, Head of Transport Services, delegate of the Minister for Roads and Road Safety, under section 98 of the **Road Safety Act 1986** (the Act), by this Order extend the application of the following provisions to the off-street parking facilities and parking access roads of the railway stations specified in the table below, particulars of which are shown cross hatched and described as ‘Car Park Area’ on the attached plans –

- (a) sections 17A, 33I, 33J, 59, 64, 65, 65A, 65C, 76, 77, 99 and 100 of the Act; and
- (b) Parts 6AA and 7 of the Act; and
- (c) the Road Safety Road Rules 2017; and
- (d) Parts 6 to 9 of, and Schedules 6 and 7 to, the Road Safety (General) Regulations 2019.

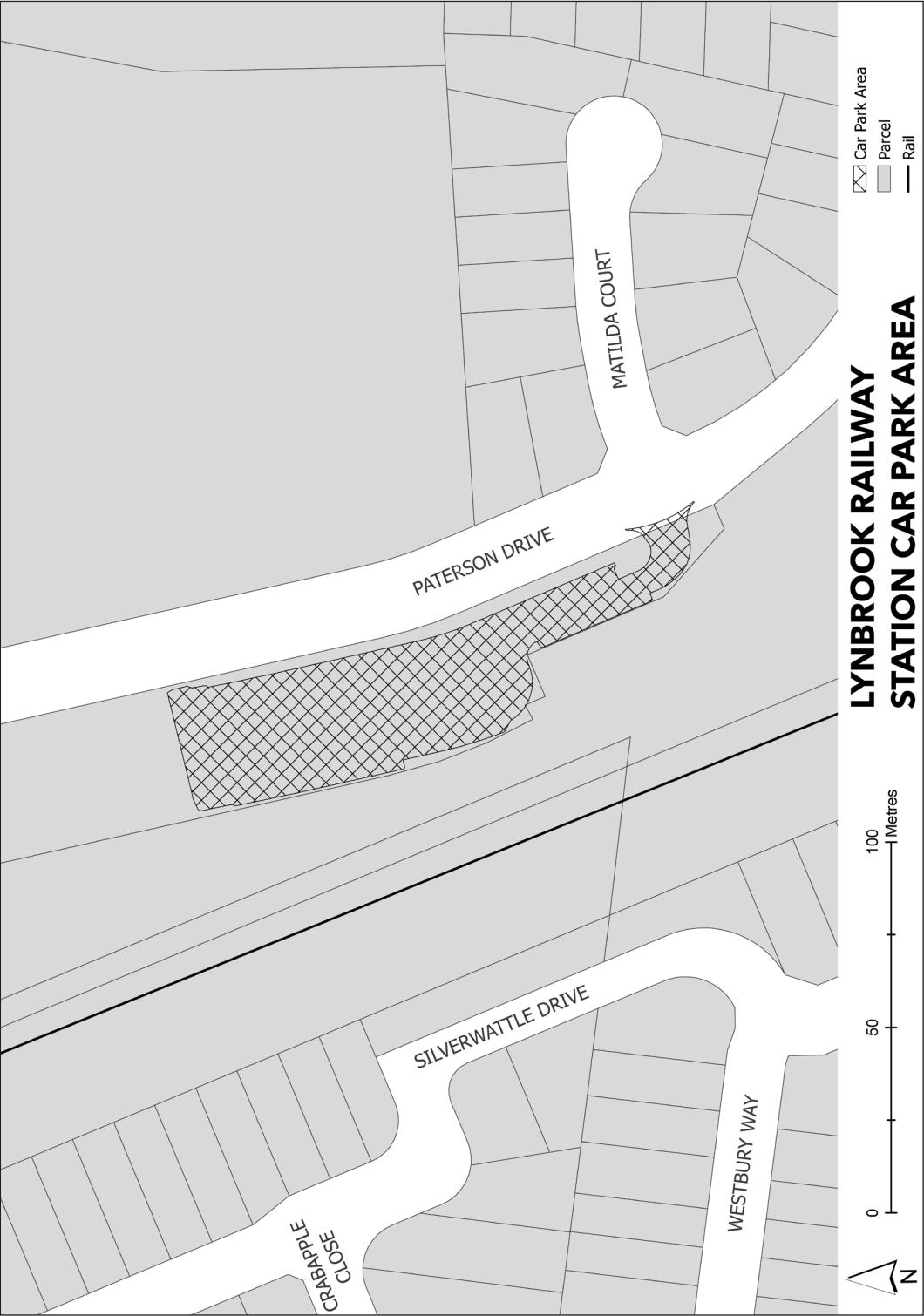

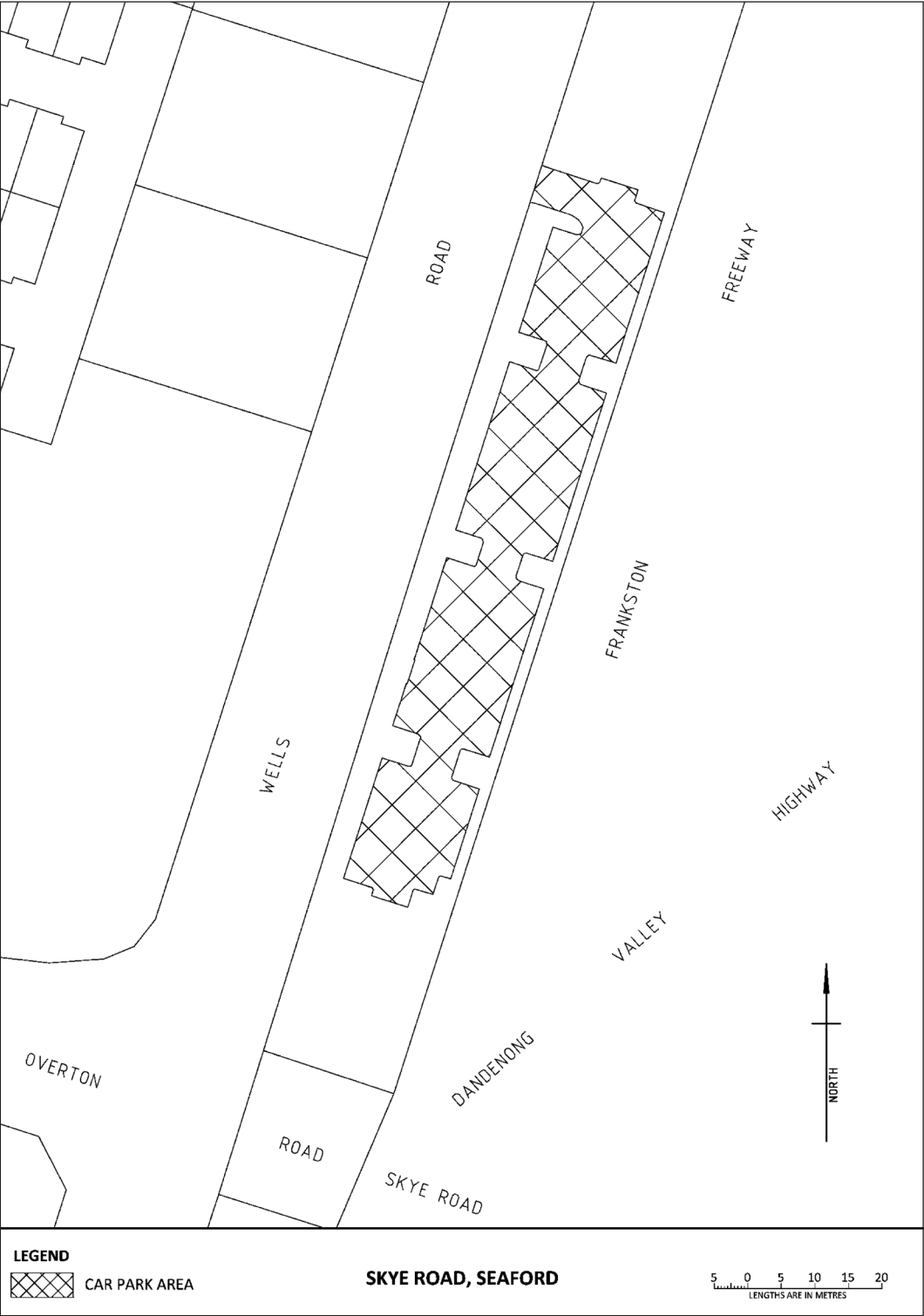

Road Safety Act 1986**ORDER UNDER SECTION 98 OF THE ROAD SAFETY ACT 1986
EXTENDING PROVISIONS TO OFF-STREET PARKING FACILITIES
AND PARKING ACCESS ROADS AT CERTAIN RAILWAY STATIONS**

I, Fiona Adamson, Head of Transport Services, delegate of the Minister for Roads and Road Safety, under section 98 of the **Road Safety Act 1986** (the Act), by this Order extend the application of the following provisions to the off-street parking facilities and parking access roads of the railway stations specified in the table below, particulars of which are shown hatched and described either as ‘Work Area’ or ‘Car Park Area’ on the attached plans –

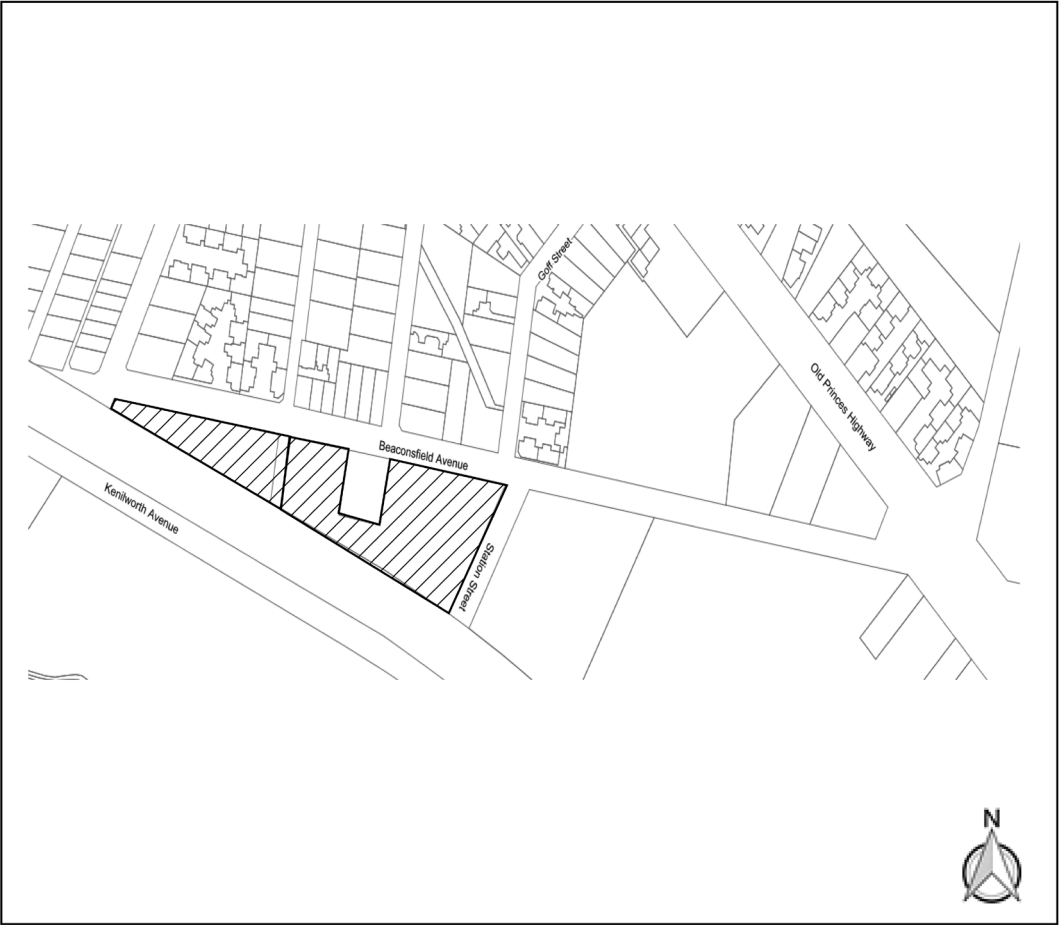
- (a) sections 17A, 33I, 33J, 59, 64, 65, 65A, 65C, 76, 77, 99 and 100 of the Act; and
- (b) Parts 6AA and 7 of the Act; and
- (c) the Road Safety Road Rules 2017; and
- (d) Parts 6 to 9 of, and Schedules 6 and 7 to, the Road Safety (General) Regulations 2019.

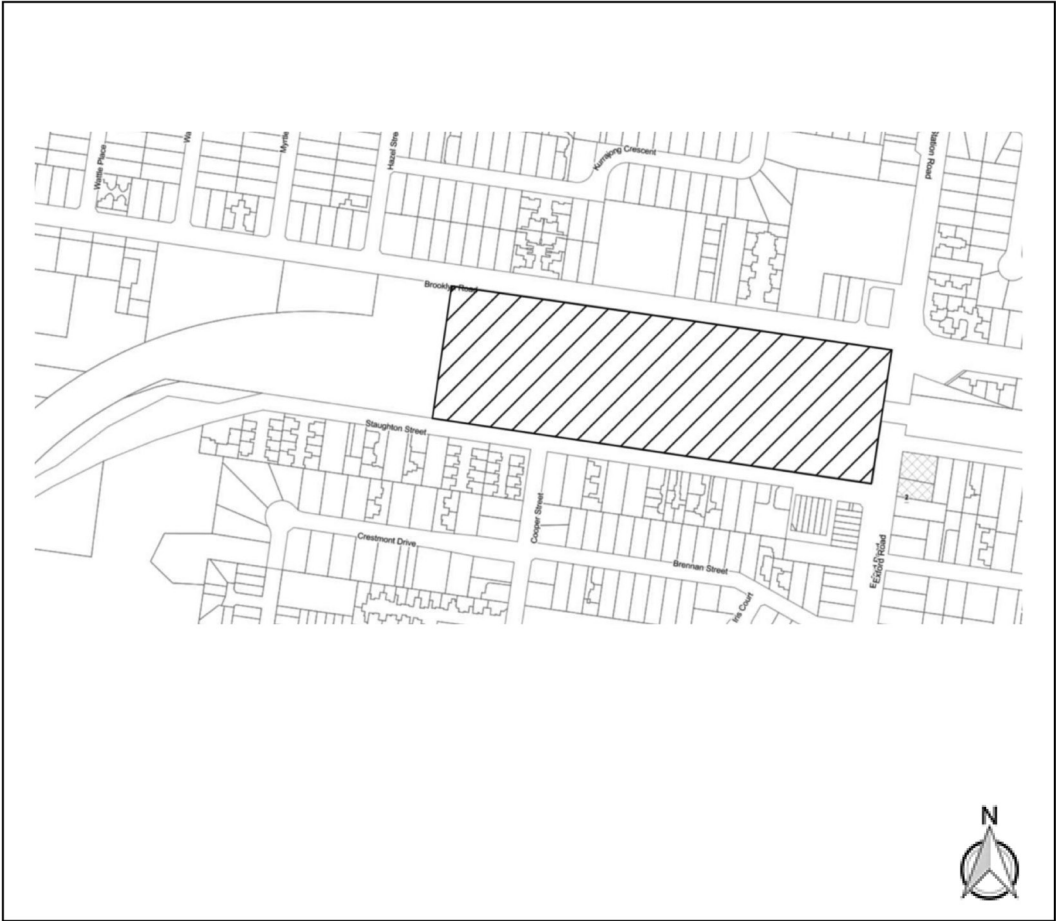

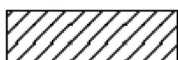

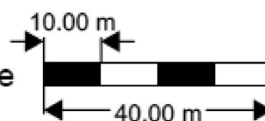

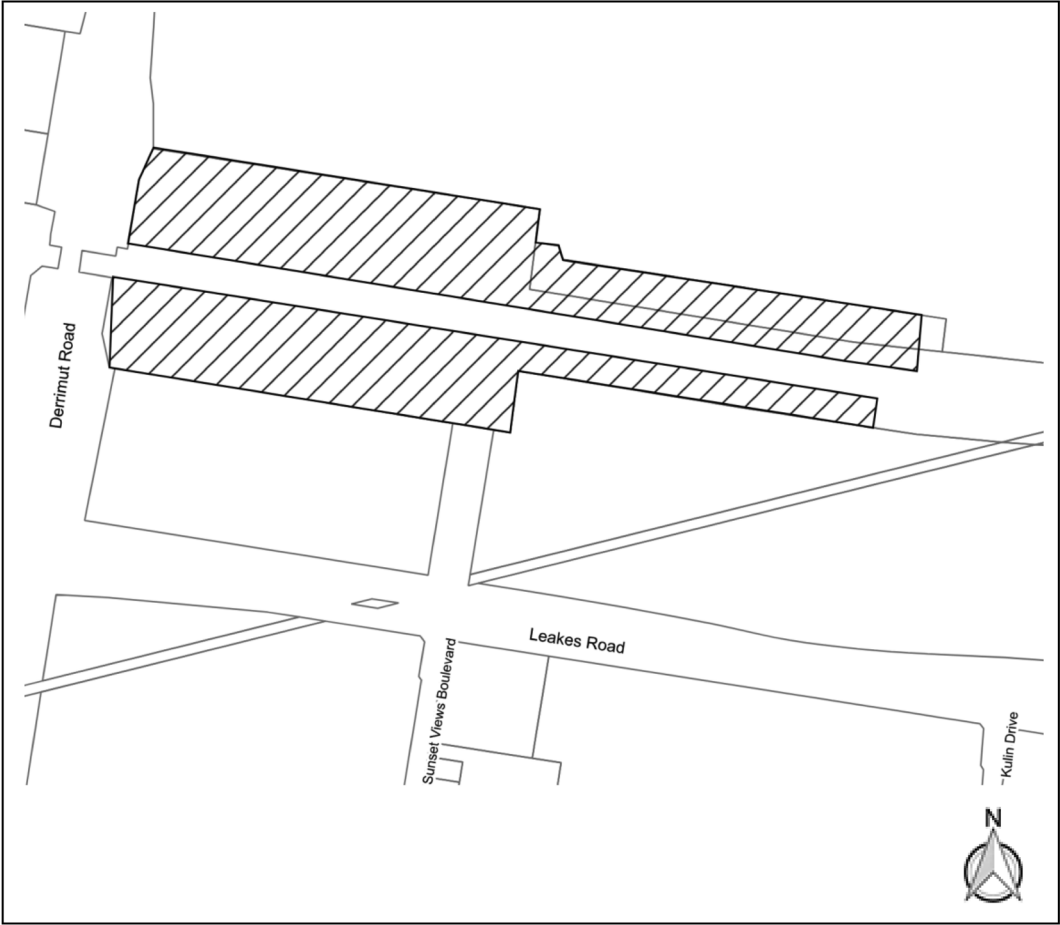
