NOTICE CONTROLLING NAVIGATION IN THE VICINITY OF WORKS

Parks Victoria, as the declared waterway manager for the waters of the Maribyrnong River upstream of Shepherd Bridge on Footscray Road, hereby gives notice under section 211(1)(b)(i) of the **Marine Safety Act 2010**.

For the purposes of the works activity proposed by Vision Civil Pty Ltd to undertake maintenance on two bridges situated on the Maribyrnong River – Lynch’s Bridge (Ballarat Road) and Hopetoun Bridge (Dynon Road).

The navigation and movement of vessels is prohibited from waters of the Maribyrnong River as detailed below in Table 1, excluding vessels involved in the works and Parks Victoria vessels.

Table 1: Maribyrnong Bridge Works

Dates	Location	Prohibited Waters	Open for Transit
23, 24 and 25 January 8.00 pm–5.00 am	Lynchs Bridge (Ballarat Road)	Centre span 4 closed to river traffic extending approx. 10 m either side of pylon on both upstream and downstream approach.	Northern span 3 and southern span 5 are open for transit.
30, 31 January and 1 February 8.00 pm–5.00 am	Lynchs Bridge (Ballarat Road)	Southern spans 5 and 6 closed to river traffic extending approx. 30 m upstream and downstream of the bridge to the southern bank.	Northern spans 3 and 4 open for transit.
2, 6 and 7 February 8.00 pm–5.00 am	Lynchs Bridge (Ballarat Road)	Northern spans 2 and 3 closed to river traffic extending approx. 30 m upstream and downstream of the bridge to the northern bank.	Southern spans 4 and 5 open for transit.
9, 13 and 14 February 8.00 pm–5.00 am	Hopetoun Bridge (Dynon Road)	Eastern half of river closed to traffic extending approx. 40 m on upstream and downstream approach.	Western span (non-powered vessel only) and partial centre span open for transit.
15 and 16 February 8.00 pm–5.00 am	Hopetoun Bridge (Dynon Road)	Western half of river closed to traffic extending approx. 40 m on upstream and downstream approach.	Eastern span and partial centre span open for transit.

The exclusion zones will be marked by lit sign floats, lit water communication buoys fitted with 1–2 nm marine lanterns and unlit stringline buoys on both upstream and downstream approaches.

Times and dates are subject to change. Changes to times, durations or days will be advertised on Parks Victoria’s website and Notice to River Users.

This notice has effect from 8.00 pm on 23 January 2023 to 5.00 am on 17 February 2023.
