DESIGNATION OF TOW-AWAY AREA UNDER SCHEDULE 4 CLAUSE 5

Tow-Away Area for 2023 Johnston Street Fiesta

Clause 5 of Schedule 4 to the **Road Management Act 2004** provides that a State road authority may move, keep or impound any vehicle that is unlawfully parked or left standing in an area designated by the Minister, (referred to in this instrument as a 'tow-away area'), and may charge the owner of the vehicle a reasonable fee.

For the purposes of that provision, I, Fatima Mohamed, Executive Director Inner Metro at the Department of Transport and Planning and delegate of the Minister for Roads and Road Safety, designate the locations specified and shown on the attached plan to be a tow-away area to facilitate the 2023 Johnston Street Fiesta to be held in Fitzroy.

This instrument takes effect at 6.00 pm on Friday, 24 February 2023 and expires at 5.00 am on Monday, 27 February 2023.

• Johnston Street between Nicholson Street and Brunswick Street, Fitzroy.
