DESIGNATION OF TOW-AWAY AREA UNDER SCHEDULE 4 CLAUSE 5

Tow-Away Area For 2023 St Kilda Festival

Clause 5 of Schedule 4 to the **Road Management Act 2004** provides that a State road authority may move, keep or impound any vehicle that is unlawfully parked or left standing in an area designated by the Minister, (referred to in this instrument as a 'tow-away area'), and may charge the owner of the vehicle a reasonable fee.

For the purposes of that provision, I, Steven Bevens, Team Leader Incident Response Services of the Department of Transport and Planning and delegate of the Minister for Roads and Road Safety, designate the locations specified and shown on the attached plans, to be a tow-away area to facilitate traffic management as part of the 2023 St Kilda Festival event.


This instrument takes effect at 12.00 am on Sunday 19 February 2023 and expires at 11.59 pm on Sunday 19 February 2023.


- Fitzroy Street between Grey Street and Esplanade, St Kilda
- Upper Esplanade between Fitzroy Street and Carlisle Street, St Kilda
- Acland Street between Carlisle Street and Belford Street, St Kilda
- Jacka Boulevard between Beaconsfield Parade and Marine Parade, St Kilda
- Lower Esplanade between Cavell Street and Jacka Boulevard, St Kilda
- Cavell Street between Upper Esplanade and Marine Parade, St Kilda
- Shakespeare Grove between Acland Street and Marine Parade, St Kilda
- Carlisle Street between Acland Street and Albert Street. St Kilda
- Park Street between Fitzroy Street and Scoops Lane
- Canterbury Road (East bound lanes) between Fitzroy Street and Felix Lane
- Beaconsfield Parade between Jacka Boulevard and Pier Road

Road Safety Act 1986

DECLARATION UNDER SECTION 99B(4) IN RELATION TO NON-ROAD ACTIVITIES IN CITY OF PORT PHILLIP FOR THE ST KILDA FESTIVAL ON SUNDAY 19 FEBRUARY 2023

1 Purpose

The purpose of this Declaration is to exempt participants in the St Kilda Festival from specified provisions of the **Road Safety Act 1986** and regulations under that Act with respect to the Event, which is a non-road activity to be conducted on the highway(s) listed in Table 2 on Sunday 19 February 2023.

2 Authorising provision

This notice is made under section 99B(4) of the **Road Safety Act 1986**. Section 99B(4) provides that the Minister for Roads and Road Safety may, on the application of a person proposing to conduct a non-road activity on a highway, by notice published in the Government Gazette, declare that specified provisions of the **Road Safety Act 1986** and of the regulations made under that Act do not apply with respect to the non-road activity specified in the notice during the period specified in the notice.

3 Commencement

This notice takes effect at 3.00 am on Sunday 19 February 2023.

4 Expiry

This notice expires at 11.59 pm on Sunday 19 February 2023.

5 Definitions

In this notice, unless the context or subject-matter otherwise requires –

- a) 'Event' means the St Kilda Festival, to be held on Sunday 19 February 2023; and
- b) 'Participants' means participants in the Event, including officers, members and authorised agents of the City of Port Phillip, whose presence is reasonably required to ensure the safe conduct of the Event.

6 Declaration

I, Neil Byrne, as delegate of the Minister for Roads and Road Safety, under section 99B(4) of the **Road Safety Act 1986** declare that the provisions of the **Road Safety Act 1986** and regulations specified in Table 1 do not apply to Participants engaged in activities forming part of the Event on the highway specified in column 1 of Table 2 on the date and during the period specified in column 2 of Table 2, provided there is full compliance with any conditions imposed by the Department of Transport and Planning and the municipal council.
