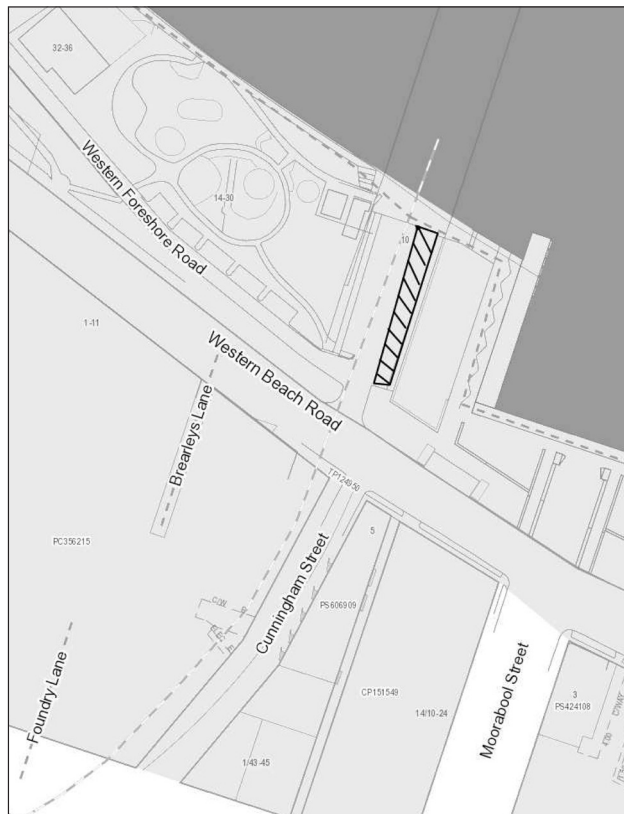

DESIGNATION OF TOW AWAY AREAS UNDER CLAUSE 4 OF SCHEDULE 11 IRONMAN 70.3 Geelong

Clause 4 of Schedule 11 to the **Local Government Act 1989** provides that a Council may move or impound any vehicle that is causing an unlawful obstruction, or that is unlawfully parked or left standing in an area designated by the Minister (referred to in this instrument as a tow away area) and may charge the owner of the vehicle a fee of up to the amount of the fee set for the purposes of Clause 3(1)(c).

I, Melissa Horne MP, Minister for Roads and Road Safety, under Clause 4 of Schedule 11 to the **Local Government Act 1989**, designate each of the locations specified below to be a tow away area from 1.00 am on 26 March 2023 until 11.00 pm on 26 March 2023.

- Ritchie Boulevard, Geelong;
- Eastern Beach Road between Bellerine Street and Garden Street, Geelong;
- the car park on the stretch of road between Cunningham Pier and Western Beach Road shown hatched on the attached plan.

Road Safety Act 1986**DECLARATION UNDER SECTION 99B(4) IN RELATION TO NON-ROAD ACTIVITIES
FOR THE 2023 IRONMAN 70.3 GEELONG ON SUNDAY 26 MARCH 2023****1 Purpose**

The purpose of this declaration is to exempt participants in the IRONMAN 70.3 Geelong from specified provisions of the **Road Safety Act 1986** and of the regulations and rules made under that Act with respect to the Event, which is a non-road activity to be conducted on the highways listed in Table 2 on Sunday 26 March 2023.

2 Authorising provision

This notice is made under section 99B(4) of the **Road Safety Act 1986**. Section 99B(4) provides that the responsible Minister may, on the application of a person proposing to conduct a non-road activity on a highway, by notice published in the Government Gazette, declare that specified provisions of the **Road Safety Act 1986** and of the regulations and rules made under that Act do not apply with respect to the non-road activity specified in the notice during the period specified in the notice.

Section 99B(7) of the **Road Safety Act 1986** provides that the responsible Minister may delegate this power to any person.

3 Commencement

This notice takes effect at 6.30 am on Sunday 26 March 2023.

4 Expiry

This notice expires at 11.59 pm on Sunday 26 March 2023.

5 Definitions

In this notice, unless the context or subject-matter otherwise requires –

- a) ‘Event’ means the IRONMAN 70.3 Geelong, to be held on Sunday 26 March 2023; and
- b) ‘Participants’ means participants in the Event, including officers, members and authorised agents of USM Events Pty Ltd T/A IRONMAN Oceania, whose presence is reasonably required to ensure the safe conduct of the Event.

6 Declaration

I, Paul Northey, as a delegate of the Minister for Roads and Road Safety, under section 99B(4) of the **Road Safety Act 1986** declare that the provisions of the **Road Safety Act 1986** and of the regulations and rules specified in Table 1 do not apply to Participants engaged in activities forming part of the Event on the highways specified in column 1 of Table 2 on the date and during the period specified in column 2 of Table 2, provided there is full compliance with any conditions imposed by the Department of Transport and Planning and the City of Greater Geelong.
