DESIGNATION OF TOW-AWAY AREA UNDER SCHEDULE 4 CLAUSE 5

Tow-away Area for Victoria Street Lunar Festival 2024

Clause 5 of Schedule 4 to the **Road Management Act 2004** provides that a State road authority may move, keep or impound any vehicle that is unlawfully parked or left standing in an area designated by the Minister, (referred to in this instrument as a ‘tow-away area’), and may charge the owner of the vehicle a reasonable fee.

For the purposes of that provision, I, Alan Fedda, Acting Head of Transport Services at the Department of Transport and Planning and delegate of the Minister for Roads and Road Safety, designate the location/s specified and shown on the attached plan, to be a tow-away area to facilitate the Victoria Street Lunar Festival 2024 event to be held in Richmond.

This instrument takes effect from 5.00 pm Saturday 3 February 2024 until 5.00 am Monday 5 February 2024:

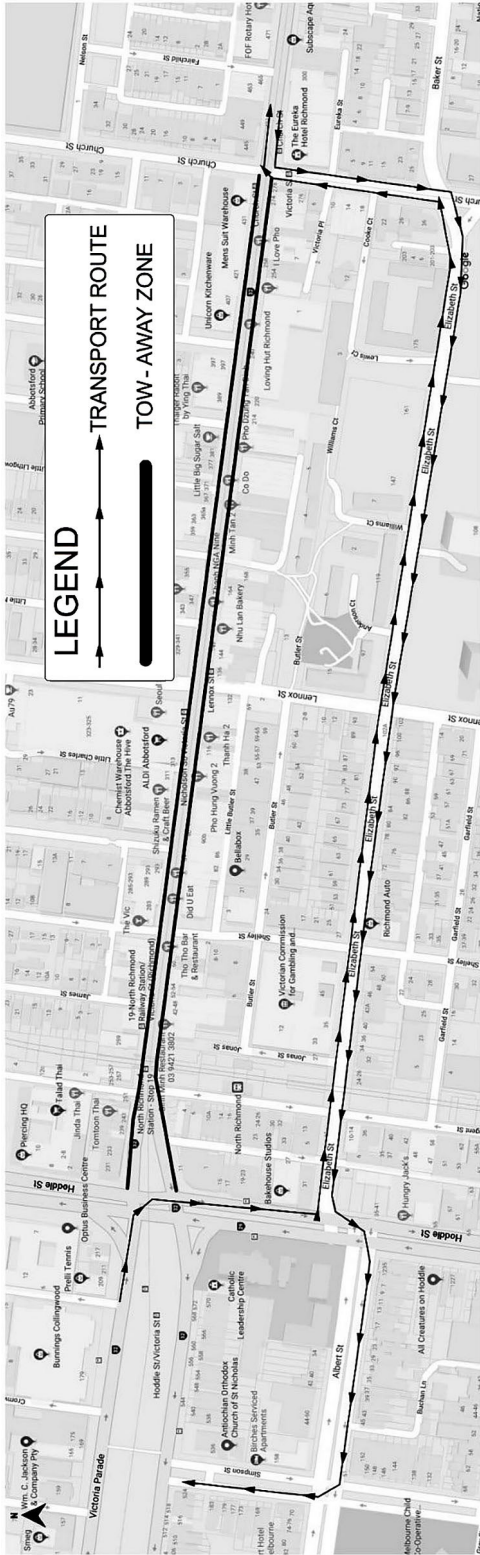
- Victoria Street, Richmond between Hoddle Street and Church Street.
