DESIGNATION OF TOW-AWAY AREA UNDER CLAUSE 5 OF SCHEDULE 4 TO THE ROAD MANAGEMENT ACT 2004 AND CLAUSE 4 OF SCHEDULE 11 TO THE LOCAL GOVERNMENT ACT 1989

Tow-Away Area for 2024 St Kilda Festival

1. Designation power

- 1.1 Clause 5 of Schedule 4 to the **Road Management Act 2004** provides that a State road authority may move, keep or impound any vehicle that is unlawfully parked or left standing in an area designated by the Minister, (referred to in this instrument as a ‘tow-away area’), and may charge the owner of the vehicle a reasonable fee.
- 1.2 Clause 4 of Schedule 11 to the **Local Government Act 1989** provides that a Council may move or impound any vehicle that is causing an unlawful obstruction, or that is unlawfully parked or left standing in an area designated by the Minister (referred to in this instrument as a ‘tow-away area’), and may charge the owner of the vehicle a fee of up to the amount of the fee set for the purposes of Clause 3(1)(c) of Schedule 11.

2. Designation

I, Jimmy O’Connell, Executive Director Network Change at the Department of Transport and Planning and delegate of the Minister for Roads and Road Safety, by this instrument under Clause 5 of Schedule 4 to the **Road Management Act 2004** and Clause 4 of Schedule 11 to the **Local Government Act 1989**, designate the locations listed below and shown on the attached plan, to be a tow-away area to facilitate the St Kilda Festival to be held in St Kilda.

3. Period of operation and list of roads

- 3.1 This instrument takes effect from 12.00 am on Sunday 18 February 2024 until 11.59 pm on Sunday 18 February 2024 in relation to the following locations:
 - a. Roads in respect of which the Head, Transport for Victoria has traffic management powers:
 - Canterbury Road (east bound), from Fitzroy Street to Felix Lane, St Kilda
 - Canterbury Road (west bound), from Fitzroy Street to West Beach Road, St Kilda
 - Beach Road, from Pier Road to 100 m South of Shakespeare Grove, St Kilda
 - b. Municipal roads in respect of which City of Port Phillip has traffic management powers:
 - Fitzroy Street, from Grey Street to Esplanade, St Kilda
 - Loch Street, from West Beach Road to Fitzroy Street, St Kilda
 - Park Street, from West Beach Road to Fitzroy Street, St Kilda
 - Acland Street, from Carlisle Street to Belford Street, St Kilda
 - Carlisle Street, from Acland Street to Barkly Street, St Kilda
 - The Esplanade, from Fitzroy Street to Carlisle Street, St Kilda

SPECIAL

- Lower Esplanade, from Cavell Street to Jacka Boulevard, St Kilda
- Cavell Street, from The Esplanade to Jacka Boulevard, St Kilda
- Shakespeare Grove, from Acland Street to Marine Parade, St Kilda.
