## **Electoral Act 2002**

### INTENTION TO DEREGISTER A POLITICAL PARTY

In accordance with section 56(1)(b) of the **Electoral Act 2002**, I give notice that the Victorian Electoral Commission (the Commission) is considering deregistering the Health Australia Party on the basis that the Commission is satisfied on reasonable grounds that the political party has ceased to have at least 500 eligible members.

The registered officer of the political party or 10 members of the political party may, within one month after the date of this notice, lodge with the Commission a signed statement setting out reasons why the political party should not be deregistered. See sections 56(3) and (4) of the **Electoral Act 2002** for more information.
