MAJOR SPORTING EVENT ORDER – TOTTENHAM HOTSPUR V NEWCASTLE UNITED FOOTBALL MATCH AT THE MELBOURNE CRICKET GROUND ON 22 MAY 2024

Order in Council

The Lieutenant-Governor, as the Governor's deputy, with the advice of the Executive Council, on the recommendation of the Minister for Tourism, Sport and Major Events, makes the following order under section 7(1) of the **Major Events Act 2009** (the Act) that the Tottenham Hotspur v Newcastle United football match to be played at the Melbourne Cricket Ground (MCG) on 22 May 2024 is a major sporting event for the purposes of the Act and in accordance with the matters specified in this Order.

Part 1 – Preliminary

1 Objective

The objective of this Order is:

- (a) to specify that the Tottenham Hotspur v Newcastle United football match to be played at the Melbourne Cricket Ground (MCG) on 22 May 2024 is a major sporting event,
- (b) to specify the matters that apply to the Tottenham Hotspur v Newcastle United football match on 22 May 2024 to be held at the MCG under the Act.

2 Citation

This Order may be referred to as the **Major Sporting Event (2024 Tottenham Hotspur v Newcastle United football match) Order**.

3 Authorising provision

This Order is made under section 7(1) of the **Major Events Act 2009**.

4 Commencement

- (a) This Order commences on the day that it is published in the Government Gazette.
- (b) This Order ends on 11.59 pm on Wednesday 22 May 2024 unless revoked earlier.

5 Definitions

In this Order –

Crowd Management Area means the area specified in clause 9(a);

crowd management period means the period specified in clause 10(c);

Event Area means the area specified in clause 9;

Event Venue means the venue specified in clause 7;

major sporting event means the events specified in clause 6;

MCG means the Melbourne Cricket Ground.

Part 2 – Content of major sporting event order

6 Major sporting event

For the purposes of section 8(1)(a) of the Act, the 2024 Tottenham Hotspur v Newcastle United football match to be held at the MCG is specified as a major sporting event for the purposes of this Order.

7 Event venue

For the purposes of section 8(1)(b) of the Act, the MCG outlined in yellow on the plan LEGL./20-064 lodged in the Central Plan Office as set out in Schedule 1 to this Order is the Event Venue for the major sporting event.

SPECIAL

8 Event organiser

For the purposes of section 8(2)(a) of the Act, TEG Sport Pty Ltd (ABN 78 654 218 934) is the event organiser for the major sporting event.

9 Event area

For the purposes of section 8(2)(b) of the Act, the following area of land is an event area for the major sporting event for the periods specified in this Order:

- (a) the area described on the plan LEGL./20-064 lodged in the Central Plan Office and outlined in red as set out in Schedule 1 to this Order (**Crowd Management Area**).

10 Application of Part 4 of the Act (Crowd management)

- (a) For the purposes of section 8(2)(i) of the Act, Part 4 of the Act applies to the major sporting event in accordance with this clause 10.
- (b) For the purposes of section 8(2)(j) of the Act, Part 4 of the Act applies to the Crowd Management Area and the Event Venue for the period specified in clause 10(c).
- (c) For the purposes of section 8(2)(e) of the Act, the crowd management period for the major sporting event is, in respect of the Crowd Management Area and the Event Venue, between 9.00 am and 11.59 pm on Wednesday 22 May 2024.

This Order comes into effect on the date that it is published in the Government Gazette.

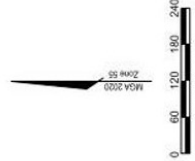

Purpose of Plan
 To define the perimeter of the Melbourne Cricket Ground and Yarra Park Event Venue and Event Area under the Major Events Act 2009.

Event Venue
 The Melbourne Cricket Ground (MCG) as defined in the Major Events Act 2009, being the area hatched yellow.

Event Area
 The area hatched red is the Event Area and includes:
 - William Barak Bridge;
 - Yarra Park Reserve, together with adjoining land up to the back of the kerb along all surrounding streets including Punt Road;
 - Land immediately outside Richmond Station on Brunton Avenue and Brunton Avenue from its intersection with Punt Road to its intersection with Jolimont Street, and
 - the three bridges across the railway lines between Yarra Park/MCG ceasing at Melbourne Park.
