PORT MANAGEMENT (LOCAL PORTS) REGULATIONS 2015

Set Aside Determination – Regulation 10

Local Port of Port Phillip

The Port Management (Local Ports) Regulations 2015 provide that the Port Manager of a local port may make a determination setting aside an area under Regulation 10 to prohibit access to an area.

Parks Victoria, as Port Manager for the Local Port of Port Phillip, has made a determination to prohibit public access to waters surrounding St Leonards boat ramp jetty to maintain public safety and facilitate works. One Set Aside area (zone) will extend approximately 30 metres around the boat ramp, as defined by on site signage, four special mark exclusion buoys and/or Notice to Mariners. Zone 1 is in effect when on site signage or Notice to Mariners stipulates that the zone is active. This Determination is in effect from 23.59 hours, Wednesday 17 July 2024, and ceasing at 23.59 hours on Monday 11 November 2024. Changes to times or dates will be advertised by Notice to Mariners and published on the Parks Victoria website.

Table 1: St Leonards Boat Ramp Jetty Works

Waters around St Leonards Boat ramp jetty, within approximate locations: Buoy 1: 38°10.7817' S, 144°42.9883' E Buoy 2: 38°10.7867' S, 144°43.0167' E Buoy 3: 38°10.815' S, 144°43.0033' E Buoy 4: 38°10.805' S, 144°42.9717' E.	The prohibited area is in effect when a Notice to Mariners stipulates the zone is active.
