VICTORIAN WORKCOVER AUTHORITY EXEMPTION

Occupational Health and Safety Regulations 2017

Exemption Numbers 24/5985, 24/5989, 24/5990, 24/5995

1. I, Sam Jenkin, Executive Director, Health and Safety, acting under regulation 537(1) of the Occupational Health and Safety Regulations 2017 (Regulations) and any and all other enabling powers hereby:
 - (a) exempt the class of person listed in item 4 of this exemption (Class of Person) from complying with the requirement in regulation 340 of the Regulations that a person must not perform construction work at a workplace unless the person holds a current construction induction card, subject to the remainder of this exemption; and
 - (b) exempt the class of person listed in item 5 of this exemption (Class of Employer) from complying with the requirements in regulations 339(1) and 341(1) of the Regulations that:
 - (i) an employer must ensure that construction induction training is provided in accordance with regulation 339 to a person who is employed to perform construction work and does not hold a current construction induction card; and
 - (ii) an employer must not knowingly allow a person whom the employer employs to perform construction work unless the person holds a current construction induction card, subject to the remainder of this exemption.
2. I am satisfied that granting this exemption will result a level of health and safety at the relevant workplace that is at least equivalent to that which would be achieved by observance of regulations 339(1), 340 and 341(1) of the Regulations.

Term of exemption

3. This exemption takes effect on the day on which notice of this exemption is published in the Government Gazette and remains in force until 21 November 2024.

Class of Person

4. This exemption applies to all persons performing construction work at Marvel Stadium, Melbourne in relation to the following concerts:
 - (a) Stray Kids 'World Tour' concert on 19 October 2024;
 - (b) Travis Scott 'Circus Maximus Tour' concerts on 22 and 23 October 2024;
 - (c) Coldplay 'Music of the Spheres World Tour' concerts on 30 and 31 October and 2 and 3 November 2024; and
 - (d) Pearl Jam 'Dark Matter World Tour' concerts on 16 and 18 November 2024.

Class of Employer

5. This exemption applies to all employers of a person included in the Class of Person in item 4.

Conditions

6. Any person in the Class of Person performing construction work who does not hold a current construction induction card must have undertaken training and an assessment of competency in accordance with the information provided to WorkSafe by Live Nation Australasia Pty Ltd.

SPECIAL

Definitions

7. Unless otherwise indicated, all terms have the same meaning as in the **Occupational Health and Safety Act 2004** or the Regulations.

WorkSafe means the Victorian WorkCover Authority.
