ORDER PROHIBITING OR RESTRICTING THE ENTRY OR IMPORTATION INTO VICTORIA OF MATERIALS WHICH ARE HOSTS OF POLYPHAGOUS SHOT-HOLE BORER

I, Rosa Crnov, as delegate of the Minister for Agriculture, being of the reasonable suspicion that the exotic pest polyphagous shot-hole borer exists within Australia but outside Victoria, make the following Order.

1 Objective

The objective of this Order is to prohibit, restrict or impose conditions upon the entry or importation into Victoria of materials which are hosts of polyphagous shot-hole borer.

2 Authorising provision

This Order is made under section 36(1) of the **Plant Biosecurity Act 2010**.

3 Commencement

This Order comes into force on 16 February 2025 and remains in force for a period of 12 months unless revoked earlier.

4 Revocation

The Order entitled *Order prohibiting or restricting the entry or importation into Victoria of materials which are hosts of polyphagous shot-hole borer* made under section 36(1) of the **Plant Biosecurity Act 2010** and published in Victoria Government Gazette G 8 on 22 February 2024 at pages 300–302 is revoked.

5 Definitions

In this Order –

agricultural equipment means any vehicle, equipment or other mechanical apparatus of any kind that has been used in relation to host plants and timber.

host material means any host plant, timber and agricultural equipment.

host plant means any plant described on the Western Australian government website (www.agric.wa.gov.au/borer) with woody stems or branches that are greater than 2.0 cm in diameter.

polyphagous shot-hole borer means the exotic pest *Euwallacea fornicatus* (Eichhoff).

seasoned timber means timber or wood including construction and fencing materials, and furniture that has been –

- dried, or
- treated to a hazard class of H2 or greater as provided in the AS/NZS 1604 series ‘Specification for preservative treatment’.

timber means wood (round or sawn, with or without bark) of any host plant including firewood and woodchips where the chips are greater than 2.5 cm, excepting seasoned timber.

6 Prohibitions, restrictions and conditions

The following prohibitions, restrictions and conditions are specified in relation to the entry or importation of host material.

- (a) The entry or importation into Victoria of any host material is prohibited.
- (b) Sub-clause (a) does not apply if the polyphagous shot-hole borer host material –
 - (i) originates from an area for which there is currently in force an area freedom certificate, being a certificate issued by an officer responsible for agriculture in the State or Territory from which the host material originated, certifying that the area from which the host material originated is known to be free of polyphagous shot-hole borer; or
 - (ii) is accompanied by a plant health certificate, assurance certificate or plant health declaration, certifying or declaring that the material has been treated in a manner prescribed in the Schedule to this Order and where a copy of the certificate or declaration is forwarded to Agriculture Victoria at market.access@agriculture.vic.gov.au prior to despatch of the material; or
 - (iii) enters Victoria under and in accordance with a permit issued by an inspector and there is compliance with any conditions or requirements set out in the permit.

7 Verification of Consignments

Where requested by an inspector, host material imported into Victoria which is required by clause 6(b)(ii) to be accompanied by a certificate or declaration, must be –

- (a) presented to an Inspector for inspection; or
- (b) verified by a person accredited to do so by the Department of Energy, Environment and Climate Action.

 - (B) 16°C–20.9°C @ 56 g/m³ for 24 hours; or
 - (C) 21°C–31.9°C @ 48 g/m³ for 24 hours; and
 - (D) where monitoring at regular intervals throughout the fumigation treatment to ensure minimum concentration is maintained at the following rates; or
