CORRIGENDUM

NOTICE CONTROLLING NAVIGATION IN THE VICINITY OF WORKS

This notice corrects an error contained in a notice published in the Special Gazette S 134 on Thursday 21 March 2024.

The exclusion zone for the Princes Bridge renewal works on the Yarra River is updated as per Table 1 below.

Table 1: Princes Bridge Renewal Works

Date	Prohibited Waters with Reduced Clearance	Works	Open for Transit
Friday 21 February 2025– Monday 19 May 2025	Southern Arch of Princes Bridge to have reduced height and width: extending approximately 8 m from the southern bank and approximately 8 m in from the bridge pier leaving a minimum 12 m transit lane through the Southern arch, as marked by buoys. Centre Arch of Princes Bridge reduced width: approximately 3 m into the arch from the southern bridge pier, as marked by buoys.	Southern Arch – Western aspect: Bluestone replacement and repair, repointing and painting.	Northern Arch – open. Centre Arch – partially open approximately 26 m width. Southern Arch – partially open with transit lane of approximately 12 m width with a reduced clearance height at a minimum of 4 m at high tide.
