Road Management Act 2004 and Local Government Act 1989

DESIGNATION OF TOW-AWAY AREA UNDER CLAUSE 5 OF SCHEDULE 4 TO THE ROAD MANAGEMENT ACT 2004 AND CLAUSE 4 OF SCHEDULE 11 TO THE LOCAL GOVERNMENT ACT 1989

Tow-Away Area for Moomba Festival 2025

1. Designation power

- 1.1 Clause 5 of Schedule 4 to the **Road Management Act 2004** provides that a State road authority may move, keep or impound any vehicle that is unlawfully parked or left standing in an area designated by the Minister, (referred to in this instrument as a ‘tow-away area’), and may charge the owner of the vehicle a reasonable fee.
- 1.2 Clause 4 of Schedule 11 to the **Local Government Act 1989** provides that a Council may move or impound any vehicle that is causing an unlawful obstruction, or that is unlawfully parked or left standing in an area designated by the Minister (referred to in this instrument as a ‘tow-away area’), and may charge the owner of the vehicle a fee of up to the amount of the fee set for the purposes of Clause 3(1)(c) of Schedule 11.

2. Designation

I, Jimmy O’Connell, Executive Director Network Change at the Department of Transport and Planning and delegate of the Minister for Roads and Road Safety, by this instrument under Clause 5 of Schedule 4 to the **Road Management Act 2004** and Clause 4 of Schedule 11 to the **Local Government Act 1989**, designate the locations listed below and shown on the attached plan, to be a tow-away area to facilitate the Moomba Festival 2025 event to be held in the City of Melbourne.

3. Period of operation and list of roads

- 3.1 This instrument takes effect from 3.00 pm on Sunday 9 March 2025 to 5.00 pm on Monday 10 March 2025 in relation to the following locations:
 - a. Roads in respect of which the Head, Transport for Victoria has traffic management powers:
 - St Kilda Road between Southbank Boulevard and Coventry Street (east side).
 - b. Municipal roads in respect of which City of Melbourne has traffic management powers:
 - Anzac Avenue between St Kilda Road and Birdwood Avenue (south side);
 - Birdwood Avenue between Dallas Brooks Drive and Anzac Avenue (both sides);
 - Birdwood Avenue between Dallas Brooks Drive and Domain Road (both sides);
 - Dallas Brooks Drive between Domain Road and Birdwood Avenue (east side);
 - Government House Drive between St Kilda Road and Birdwood Avenue (north side);
 - Linlithgow Avenue between St Kilda Road and Alexandra Avenue (both sides);

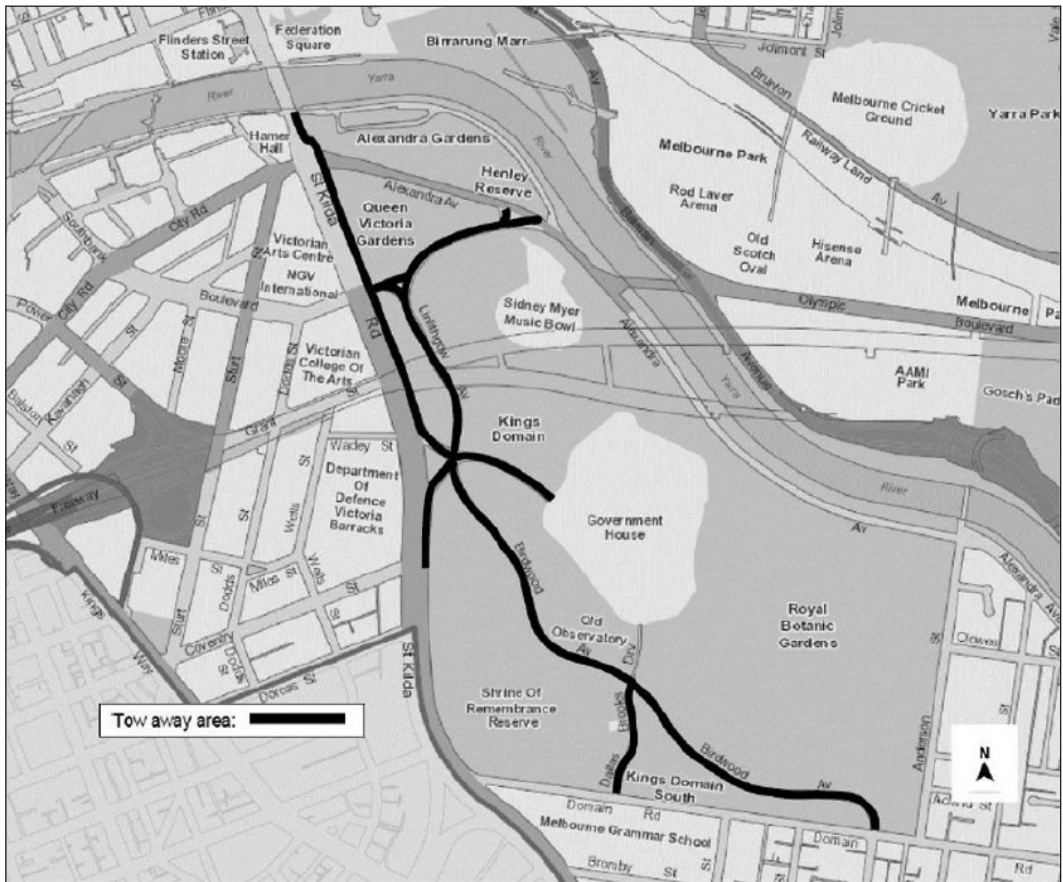
SPECIAL
