PORT MANAGEMENT (LOCAL PORTS) REGULATIONS 2015

Set-Aside Determination – Regulations 10(1)(c) and 12(b)

Local Port of Port Phillip

The Port Management (Local Ports) Regulations 2015 provide that the Port Manager of a local port may make a determination setting aside an area under Regulation 10 to prohibit access to an area, and Regulation 12 (b) A port manager may make a determination to set aside an area in a local port in which the mooring, berthing or anchoring of a vessel is Prohibited.

Parks Victoria, as Port Manager for the Local Port of Port Phillip, has made a determination to prohibit public access to waters surrounding the Fisherman's Jetty construction site to maintain public safety and facilitate works. A set-aside area (zone) is the area within a boundary defined by signs, buoys and Notice to Mariners. Zones 1 is in effect when signs, buoys and Notice to Mariners stipulate that the zone is active. This Determination is in effect from 08.00 hours, Monday April 7 2025, and ceasing at 23.59 hours on Tuesday 30 September 2025. Changes to times or dates will be advertised by Notice to Mariners and published on the Parks Victoria website.
