PORT MANAGEMENT (LOCAL PORTS) REGULATIONS 2015

Set-Aside Determination – Regulation 11

Local Port of Port Phillip

The Port Management (Local Ports) Regulations 2015, Regulation 11(1)(a) or (b), enables the Port Manager of a local port to make a determination to prohibit or restrict access in certain areas for no more than 90 days.

Parks Victoria, as Port Manager for the Local Port of Port Phillip, has made a determination to prohibit public access to waters surrounding Frankston Pier to maintain public safety and facilitate works. A single set-aside area (Zone 1) is the area within a boundary defined by a 20 metre offset from the pier, as defined by signs, buoys and Notice to Mariners. Zone 1 is in effect when signs, buoys and Notice to Mariners stipulates that the zone is active. This Determination is in effect from 08.00 hours, Monday 7 April 2025, and ceasing at 18.00 hours on Saturday 12 April 2025. Changes to times or dates will be advertised by Notice to Mariners and published on the Parks Victoria website.
