NOTICE CONTROLLING NAVIGATION IN THE VICINITY OF WORKS

This Notice formally revokes and replaces the notice published in the Special Government Gazette No. S 121 Thursday 20 March 2025.

Parks Victoria, as the declared waterway manager for the waters of the Yarra River upstream of the port waters of the Port of Melbourne makes the following notice under section 211(1)(b)(i) of the **Marine Safety Act 2010** (the Act).

For the purposes of the works activity proposed by Symal Infrastructure Pty Ltd on behalf of the City of Melbourne to undertake construction of the Greenline boardwalk in the Yarra River, this notice supersedes and amends the previous notice published in the Victoria Government Gazette G 16 page 705 on Thursday 18 April 2024.

The navigation and movement of vessels is prohibited from the waters detailed in Table 1 below, excluding vessels involved in the works.

Approximately 35 metres width is open for vessel movement, on the southern section of the river.

Boardwalk 1 Friday 1 August to Friday 19 December 2025	Waters beginning at the upstream edge of Federation Wharf extending approximately 175 metres upstream along the northern bank to Birrarung Marr Landing, reaching approximately 25 metres into the river as marked by buoys.	Boardwalk construction	Approximately 45 metres width is open for vessel movement, on the southern section of the river.
Boardwalk 3 Friday 1 August to Friday 19 December 2025	Waters beginning approximately 160 metres upstream of Birrarung Marr Landing, extending approximately 135 metres along the northern bank, reaching approximately 25 metres into the river as marked by buoys.		Approximately 40 metres width is open for vessel movement, on the southern section of the river.

The exclusion zone will be marked by unlit stringline buoys, lit water communication buoys fitted with 1–2 nm marine lanterns and lit warning signage on approach from both directions.

This notice has effect from 7.00 am Monday 14 April to 6.00 pm Friday 19 December 2025.
