Road Management Act 2004 and Local Government Act 1989

DESIGNATION OF TOW-AWAY AREA UNDER CLAUSE 5 OF SCHEDULE 4 TO THE ROAD MANAGEMENT ACT 2004

TOW-AWAY AREA FOR 12 FEBRUARY EVENT

1. Designation power

- 1.1 Clause 5 of Schedule 4 to the **Road Management Act 2004** provides that a State road authority may move, keep or impound any vehicle that is unlawfully parked or left standing in an area designated by the Minister, (referred to in this instrument as a ‘**tow-away area**’), and may charge the owner of the vehicle a reasonable fee.

2. Designation

I, Jimmy O’Connell, Executive Director Network Change at the Department of Transport and Planning and delegate of the Minister for Roads and Road Safety, by this instrument under Clause 5 of Schedule 4 to the **Road Management Act 2004**, designate the location/s listed below and shown on the attached plan, to be a tow-away area to facilitate the 12 February Event to be held in the City of Port Phillip.

3. Period of operation and list of roads

- 3.1 This instrument takes effect from 12.01 am on Thursday 12 February 2026 to 7.00 pm on Thursday 12 February 2026 in relation to the following locations:
- a. Roads in respect of which the Head, Transport for Victoria has traffic management powers:
- City Road between Whiteman Street and Cecil Street, Southbank

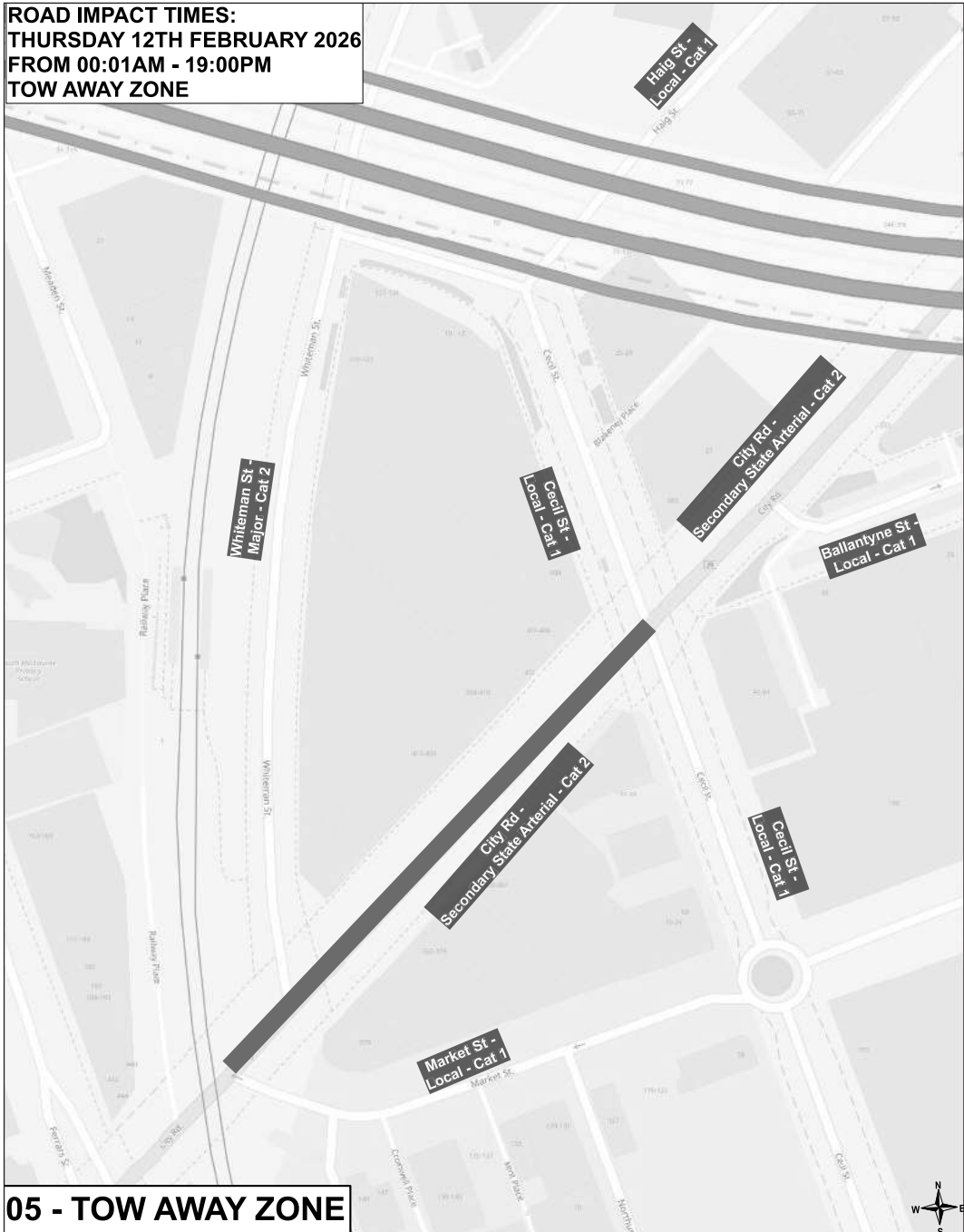
