NOTICE OF PREPARATION OF REGULATORY IMPACT STATEMENT

Proposed Road Management (Works and Infrastructure) Regulations 2026 and Road Management (General) Regulations 2026

I, Melissa Horne MP, Minister for Roads and Road Safety and Minister responsible for administering the **Road Management Act 2004**, give notice in accordance with section 11 of the **Subordinate Legislation Act 1994** that a regulatory impact statement (RIS) has been prepared in relation to the proposed Road Management (Works and Infrastructure) Regulations 2026 and Road Management (General) Regulations 2026 (the proposed Regulations).

These Regulations are proposed to replace the Road Management (Works and Infrastructure) Regulations 2015 and the Road Management (General) Regulations 2016 which expire on 14 June 2026 in accordance with section 5 of the **Subordinate Legislation Act 1994**.

The objective of the proposed Regulations is to create an effective legal framework to ensure that public roads are adequately managed.

The RIS assesses the merits of the proposed Regulations and possible alternatives, and concludes that the proposed Regulations are the best means to achieve the objective outlined above.

The purpose of this notice is to invite public comments or submissions on the proposed Regulations and the RIS. Copies of the proposed Regulations and RIS may be obtained from www.engage.vic.gov.au

The Department of Transport and Planning seeks public comments or submissions on the proposed Regulations and RIS by no later than 5 May 2026. Comments or submissions should be submitted through the above website.

All public comments or submissions will be treated as public documents, unless the person making a public comment or submission requests that it not be publicly available.
