## Transport (Compliance and Miscellaneous) Act 1983

AMENDING CONDITIONS NO. 3/2026

Determined Under Section 220D(1)

The Head, Transport for Victoria, the entity established under section 64A of the **Transport Integration Act 2010**, hereby determines, under section 220D(1) of the **Transport (Compliance and Miscellaneous) Act 1983**, the following conditions (the Amending Conditions No. 3/2026) which amend the conditions under section 220D(1) of the **Transport (Compliance and Miscellaneous) Act 1983** published in Government Gazette No. S 141 on Friday 13 March 2026 and as amended by the amending conditions published in Government Gazette No. S 171 on Monday 30 March 2026 and No. S 217 on Monday 27 April 2026.

The Amending Conditions No. 3/2026 take effect on 11 May 2026.

## Transport (Compliance and Miscellaneous) Act 1983

AMENDING CONDITIONS NO. 3/2026

Determined Under Section 220D(1)

The Conditions under section 220D(1) of the **Transport (Compliance and Miscellaneous) Act 1983** published in Government Gazette No. S 141 on Friday 13 March 2026 as amended by the amending conditions published in Government Gazette No. S 171 on Monday 30 March 2026 and No. S 217 on Monday 27 April 2026 are amended as follows:

After paragraph 8.90 insert –

‘MYKI PASS EXTENSION FOR MYKI PASS EXPIRING BETWEEN 31 MARCH AND 31 MAY 2026

8.90A If a customer has a myki Pass that –

- (a) was valid for any period between 31 March to 10 May 2026 and the myki Pass expired during that period, the myki smartcard (on which the myki Pass was loaded) will be automatically loaded with a new myki Pass with twice the number of days for which the original myki Pass was valid during that period; or
- (b) is valid for any period between 11 and 31 May 2026 and the myki Pass will expire during that period the myki smartcard (on which the myki Pass is loaded) will be automatically loaded with a new myki Pass with twice the number of days for which the original myki Pass is valid during that period.

In order to use the new myki Pass, a customer will need to tap on the myki smartcard at the PTV app, a ticket office or a myki machine (stationary), including a Quick Topup and Enquiry Machine. Customers with Mobile myki will be able to use their myki Pass immediately by tapping on at a smartcard and digital token reader.’
